Eligibility criteria for IPv4 address space issued via the ARIN Waiting List policy



Eligibility criteria for Waiting List reissuance

ARIN presently applies common sense eligibility criteria for IPv4 address space to be issued via the ARIN Waiting List policy.

- Returned in accordance with Registration Services Agreement terms, or
- Revoked in accordance with Registration Services Agreement terms – including a registered letter to organization last known postal address
- No evidence of significant usage on the public Internet in the last 180 days (as evidenced by routing history for the block)
- More than one year since the date of return or revocation



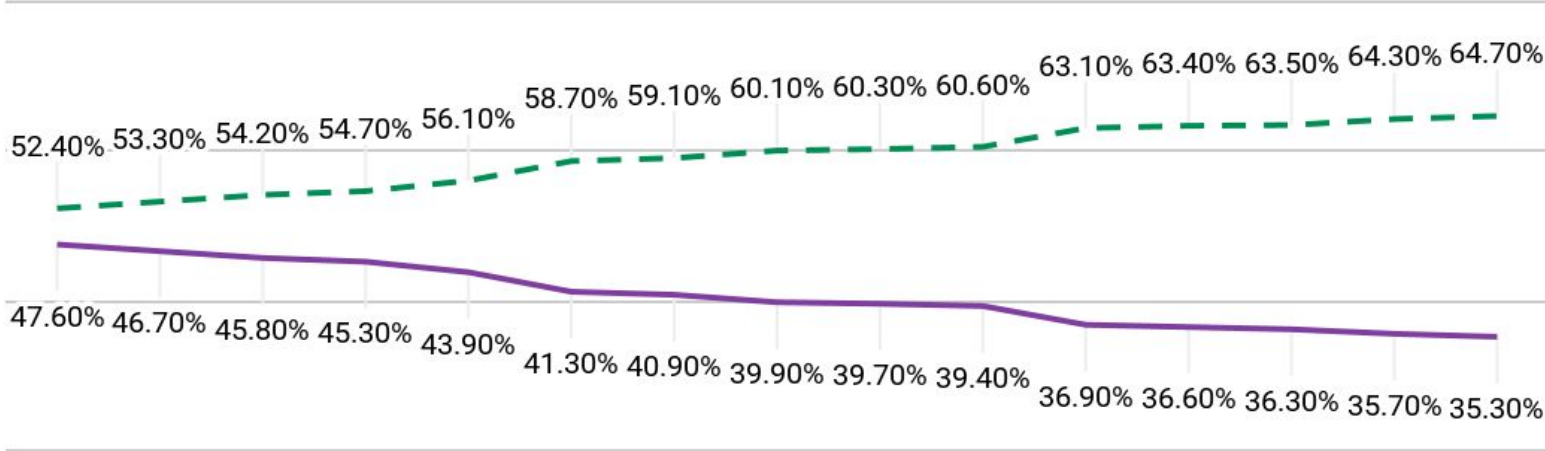
Should this criteria be in Internet number resource policy anywhere, or left to ARIN's discretion?



Legacy Number Resource Statistics

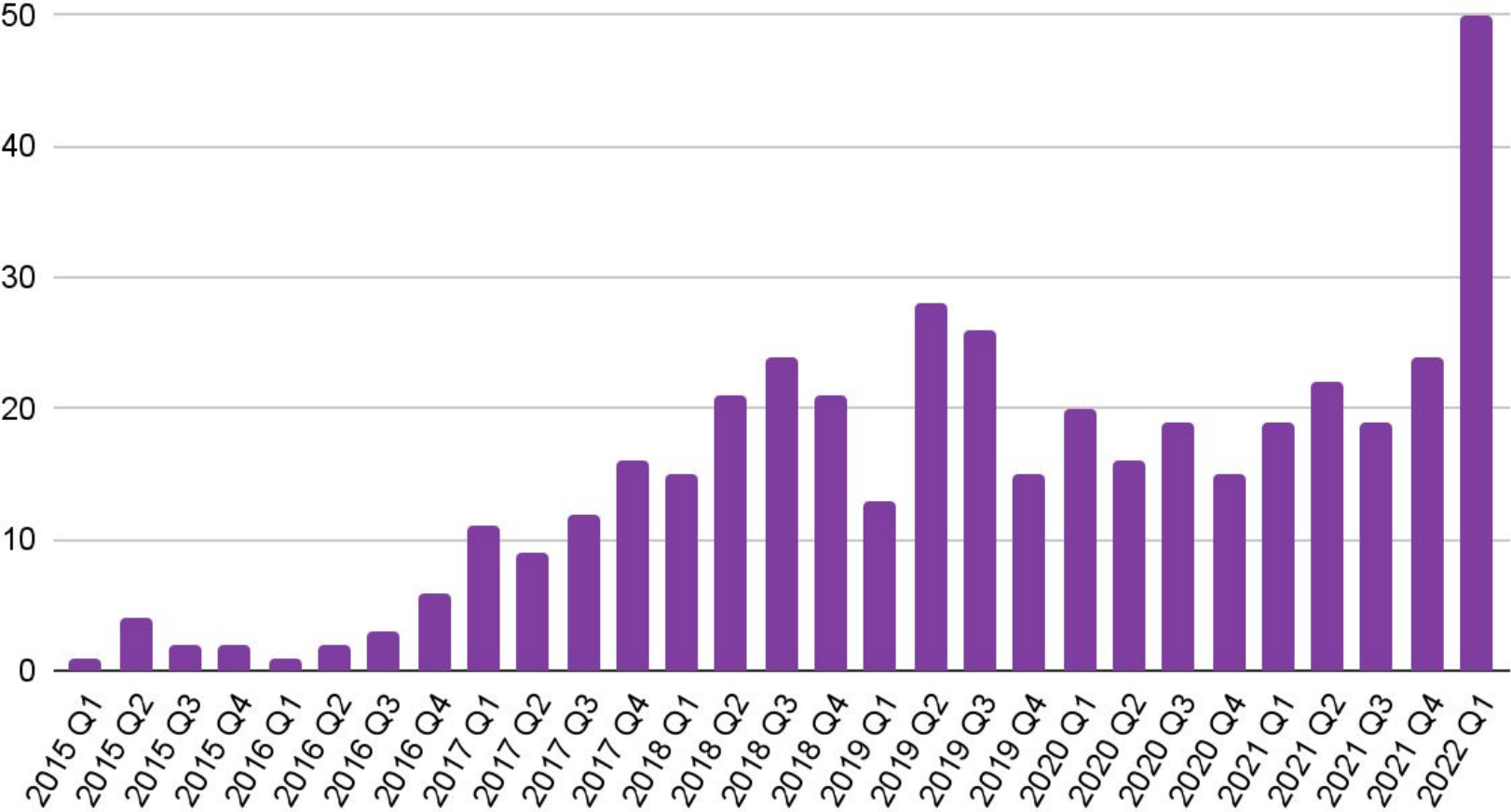
Registration Services Agreement Coverage Over Time
