Re: Affirmation of Collaboration on Digital Resilience and Internet Development

On behalf of the Government of St. Kitts and Nevis, I am pleased to affirm our constructive collaboration with the American Registry for Internet Numbers (ARIN) in support of national and regional digital resilience and responsible Internet governance.

Over the course of our engagements, including the ARIN Caribbean Roundtable, ARIN Public Policy and Members Meetings, and ARIN in the Caribbean workshops and seminars, our teams have advanced practical cooperation across areas of shared priority. These include:

- strengthening resilience in Internet number resource management;
- contributing to open and transparent Internet number public policy processes;
- promoting routing security and best practices;
- supporting the development and strengthening of Internet Exchange Points (IXPs);
- opportunities for nationals of St. Kitts and Nevis to participate in ARIN Grant and Fellowship Programs.

The Government values ARIN's ongoing technical guidance, capacity-building programmes, and multi-stakeholder approach. In this regard, we reiterate our mutual commitment to: (i) responsible and inclusive Internet governance, (ii) strengthening human resource capacity within government and industry, (iii) enhancing the security, reliability, and resilience of our national Internet infrastructure, and (iv) collaborating, where appropriate, to advance broader Caribbean Internet development objectives.

For clarity, this letter is a non-binding expression of goodwill and intent. It does not create legal obligations or exclusive commitments for either party, nor does it constitute a partnership, agency, or joint venture. Any specific activities that may arise from this collaboration would be defined and agreed separately through the appropriate channels.

I welcome the opportunity to coordinate next steps, including technical exchanges, training opportunities, and stakeholder briefings aligned to our national priorities.
