## 2.4. Local Internet Registry (LIR)

A Local Internet Registry (LIR) is an IR that primarily assigns <u>IP</u> address<u>es</u> to the users of the network services that it provides. LIRs are generally Internet Service Providers (ISPs), whose customers are primarily end users and possibly other ISPs.

## 2.5. Allocation, Assignment, Reallocation, Reassignment

Allocation <u>IP addresses</u> delegated to an organization directly by ARIN for the purpose of subsequent distribution by the recipient organization to other parties.

Assignment — IP addresses delegated to an organization directly by ARIN for the exclusive use of the recipient organization.

Reallocation <u>IP</u> addresses sub-delegated to an organization by an upstream provider for the purpose of subsequent distribution by the recipient organization to other parties.

Reassignment <u>IP addresses</u> sub-delegated to an organization by an upstream provider for the exclusive use of the recipient organization.

Note that the authorized incidental or transient use by third parties of <u>IP</u> addresses delegated to an organization shall not be considered a reassignment or a violation of the exclusive use provision.
