Finances 2023

- General operations: USD \$582,250
 - ASO, NRO and IANA Review Committee Secretariat support.
 - NRO Meetings and Communications (teleconferences)
 - ASO AC Chair travel to ICANN Meetings
 - Internet Governance Support
- Contribution to ICANN: USD \$823,000 (IANA Contract USD \$650,000 and voluntary contribution USD \$173,000)
- New NRO Programs USD \$375,000
- Stability Fund. (Updated October 2022)
 - Joint RIR provision/pledge of USD \$2.65M
