Security Update



Focusing on basics to enhance security

- Implemented quarterly vulnerability scans
- Required two-factor authentication across internal and external systems
- Annual security audit (penetration test)
- Incident response, continuity, and recovery exercises
- Review and improve controls, policies, & procedures
- InfoSec Training and Phishing Awareness Program

- Payment Card **Industry Data Security Standard**
- Applies to companies accepting payment card transactions

Type 2 Report

- Scope: Organizational security & Resource Public Key Infrastructure (RPKI)
- Type I Audit: Final report received December 2022
- Type II Audit: Ran December 2022 to September 2023, report expected by 31 October

PCI DSS Update





- Scope: Organizational security & ARIN Online
- Penetration test results completed in August
- Increased to quarterly vulnerability scanning in 2023
- Questionnaire completed in 2023

- RPKI SOC 2 Type I (2022) Type II (2023)
- ARIN Online PCI DSS (2023)
- ARIN Online SOC 2 Type II (as early as 2025)
- Other Services SOC 2 Type II (as early as 2026)
