ASN Fee Harmonization

The Fee Harmonization process – initiated on 1 January 2022 – is now complete. Effective 1 January 2024, ARIN:

Transitioned ASNs to the Registration Services Plan (RSP) Fee Schedule

Converted ASN-only holders to Service Members, making them eligible for General Membership

Removed the \$550 ASN issuance fee

Service vs. General Membership



Service Members are organizations that have signed an ARIN Agreement for IPv4 or IPv6 address space and/or ASNs.

If ARIN's governance is important to your organization, Service Members can elect to become General Members.

- General Members express commitment to participate in an ARIN Election at least once every three years to maintain their status.
- Organizations may choose to cast a blank ballot.



ARIN provides basic services to approximately 14,000 customers who hold Internet number resources that are not currently covered under any type of agreement with ARIN.


Steps to become a General Member



ARIN *

- 1. In 'Your Records,' select 'Organization Identifiers.'
- 2. Then select the Org Handle for which you want to request General Membership.
- 3. On the Organization Record page, select 'Request General Membership' from the Actions drop-down menu.

Steps to Verify a Voting Contact

Log in to ARIN Online

- Select Your Records > Organization
 Identifiers
- Select an Org Handle associated with your Account
- If you have designated a Voting Contact, it will be displayed in the Voting Contact section.
- If no Voting Contact is listed, in the Org Info section, select "Manage Voting Contact" from the Actions menu to assign one.

Candidates must self-nominate and complete the nominee questionnaire by the deadline.



A third-party vendor is solely responsible for assessing all nominees.



The initial slate of candidates will be published; any nominee that is not placed on the initial slate may petition.
