APNIC



Reached consensus at APNIC 57:

- prop-154: Resizing of IPv4 assignment for the IXPs
 - Default size of IPv4 assignments for IXPs from /23 to /26.
 - Similar to ARIN-2023-2: /26 initial IPv4 allocation for IXPs (abandoned)
- prop-156: Assignment of Temporary IP Resources
 - Reserves a /21, a /29, and 8 ASNs for temporary assignments to be made from this reserved space for purposes such as conferences, workshops, etc.

APNIC



Did not reach consensus at APNIC 57:

- prop-157: Temporary IPv4 Transfers
 - This proposal suggests a policy change to allow temporary transfers.
- prop-158: IPv6 auto-allocation for each IPv4 request
 - Automatically delegate IPv6 address to initial IPv4 requests to accelerate IPv6 implementation.

LACNIC



Under Discussion:

- LAC-2023-3: Considerations for Declaring a Proposal Abandoned
 - This would consider proposals to be abandoned if they remain "Not Reached Consensus" or "Not Ratified" for a period of 12 months.
- LAC-2023-7: Temporary Transfers
 - Similar to the Temporary Transfers policy proposal in the APNIC Region.

LACNIC



Not Ratified:

• LAC-2023-5: Delete ROAs for Recovered Resources

Did Not Reach Consensus:

- LAC-2022-2: Clarification: The lease of resources is not allowed under the policies in force
- LAC-2023-6: Special exception for global critical infrastructure providers

RIPE NCC



Concluding Phase: Last Call

- 2023-04: Add AGGREGATED-BY-LIR status for IPv4 PA assignments
 - Option to register contiguous IPv4 PA assignments under a single INETNUM object with the status AGGREGATED-BY-LIR when these assignments have identical purpose and contact details.
 - Last Call ended 9 April

RIPE NCC



Accepted and Implemented (Sep 2023):

- 2023-1 Reducing IXP IPv4 assignment default size to /26
 - Similar to ARIN-2023-2: /26 initial IPv4 allocation for IXPs (abandoned).
- 2023-3 Voluntary Transfer Lock
 - Holder can voluntarily lock resources from being transferred for a period of 6 months, 12 months and/or 24 months.
