Annual and Financial Reports




- We recently published our 2023 Annual Report and Financial Report

This report analyses the Internet Exchange Point (IXP) landscape in the Arabic-speaking countries in the Middle East, and presents a benchmarking framework to evaluate their effectiveness:

- Keeping local traffic local
- Fostering local interconnection for developing a digital economy
- Attracting global cloud and content players
- Becoming a hub for exchanging regional traffic

It examines enabling circumstances to achieve these objectives and provides recommendations for the future.


Sanctions and the Internet: A Report

Policymakers, tech companies, and other actors that deal with sanctions and care about their impact on access to the Internet can use the report to:

- Decide which Internet actors are or can be affected by sanctions and whether there is a major impact on Internet access now or in the future
- Pursue strategies that impose targeted (smart) sanctions that do not impact access to the Internet
- Contribute to clear compliance regimes that mitigate the impact of sanctions on access to the Internet






Email and Other Challenges
