Six Steps to Get You Ready for ARIN Elections

- 1. Get to know the candidates
- 2. Join the General Members Mailing List
- 3. View or make Statements of Support
- 4. Watch the Virtual Candidate Forum recording
- 5. Listen to candidate speeches
- 6. CAST YOUR VOTE!



Who Can Vote?



An organization must have been a **General Member in Good Standing** with a designated **Voting Contact** as of 15 September.



Organizations could update their Voting Contact after the Voting Eligibility deadline, but all changes had to be finalized at least seven days before the voting period begins, which was 23 October.

Accessing Your Ballot

After 3:00 PM ET/Noon PT today, **Eligible Voting Contacts** should:

- 1. Log in to **ARIN Online**
- 2. Select the "Vote Now" link
- 3. Cast ballots for the **Board of Trustees, Advisory Council, and NRO NC**






Understanding Your Ballot



When viewing your ballot, you will see:

- Your name and vote weight
- The organizations you are casting a ballot on behalf of
- The email address that will receive the confirmation email





Candidate Assessment Criteria & Guidance for Third-party vendor

- Qualified candidates meet all mandatory attributes, demonstrate the ability to perform all duties and responsibilities, and meet the highest standards of integrity and professional competence.
- **Well-qualified** candidates (Board only) have additional attributes. For 2025:
 - CPA or equivalent, CFO preferred
 - Executive compensation and succession planning
- Qualifications Not Confirmed candidates' materials (Board only) did not conclusively meet all the requirements for a Qualified rating.
- Unable to Qualify candidates demonstrate grounds for disqualification as outlined in the Nominee Assessment Guidelines*.

Understanding Your Ballot


The full ballot for all elections will be presented at one time on the same screen

- One for the NRO NC










Review Your Choices
