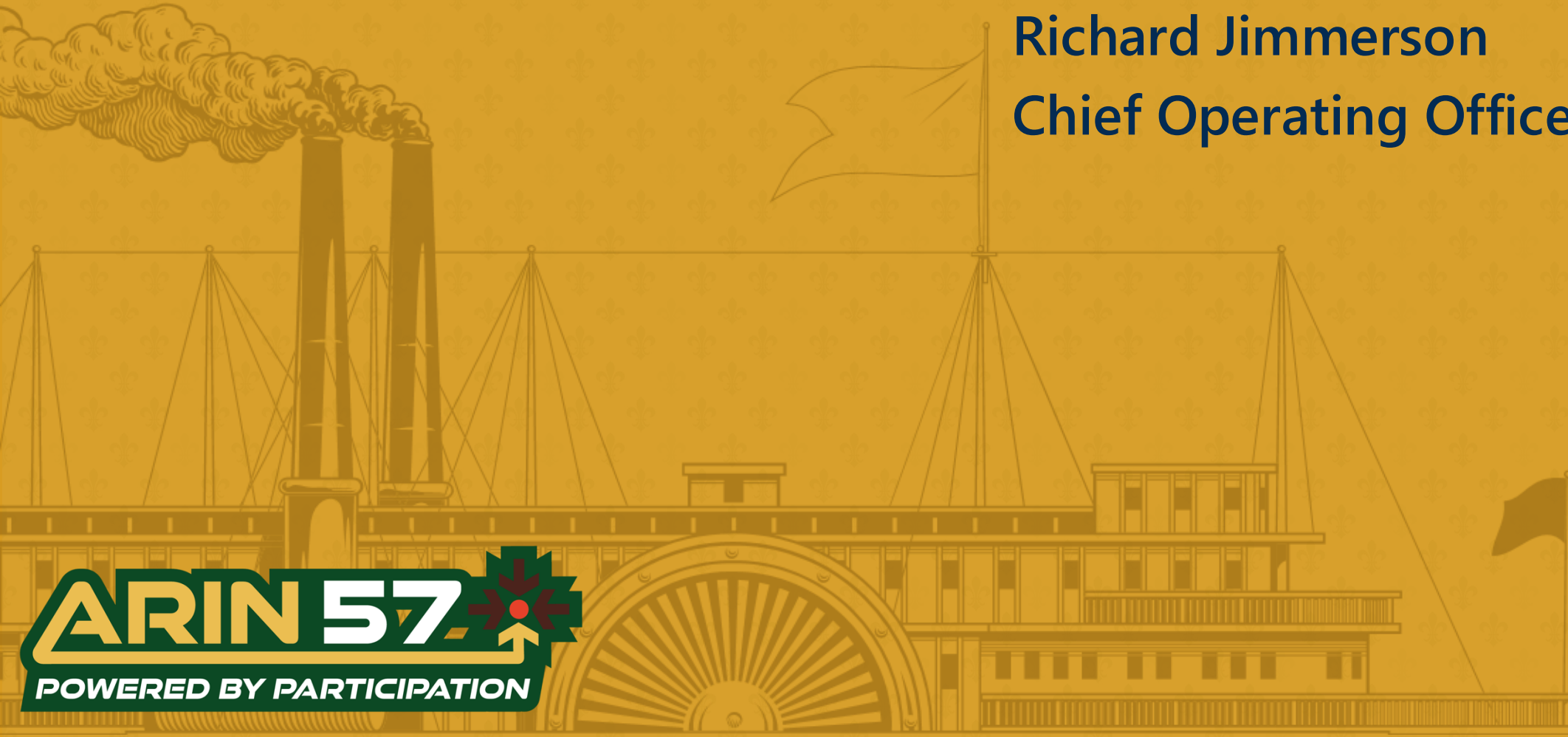

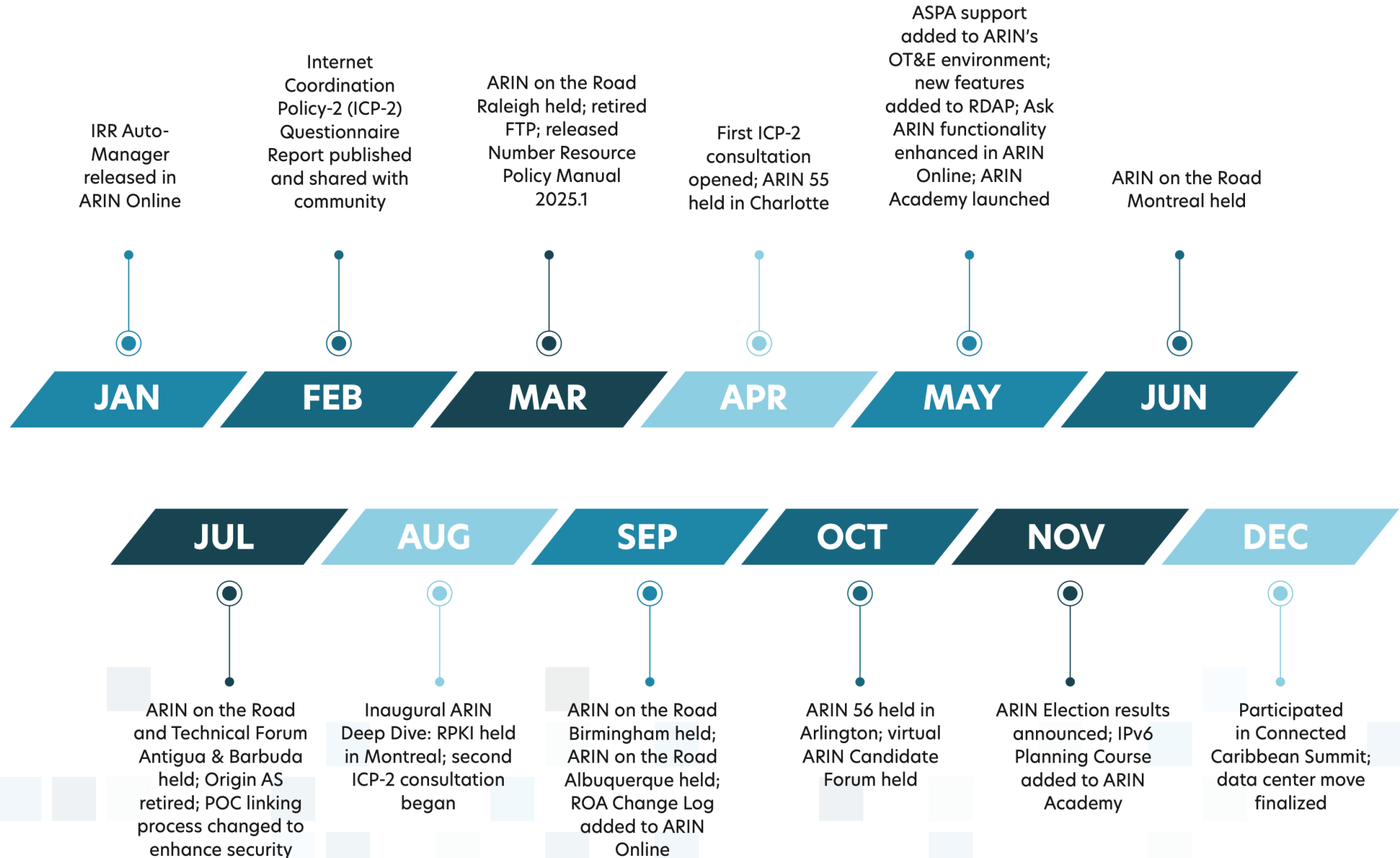
2025 Executive Summary

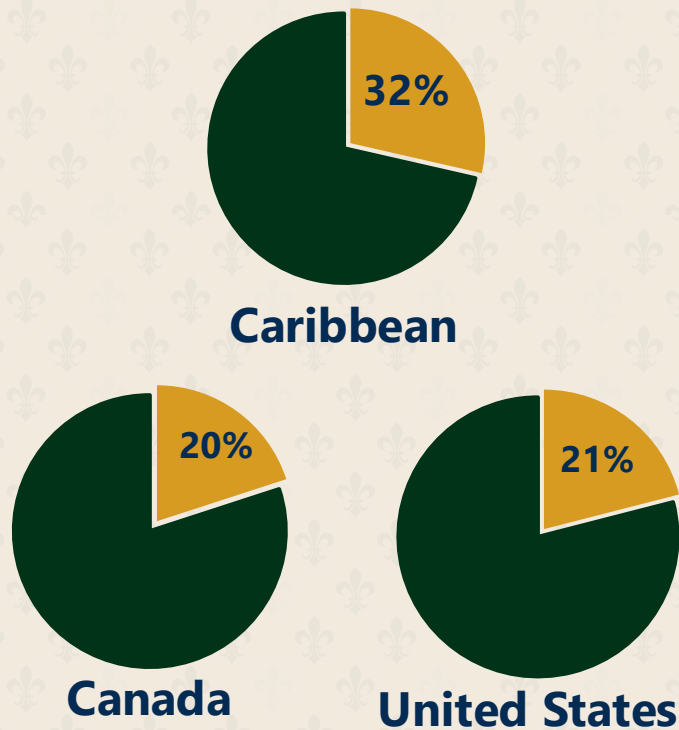

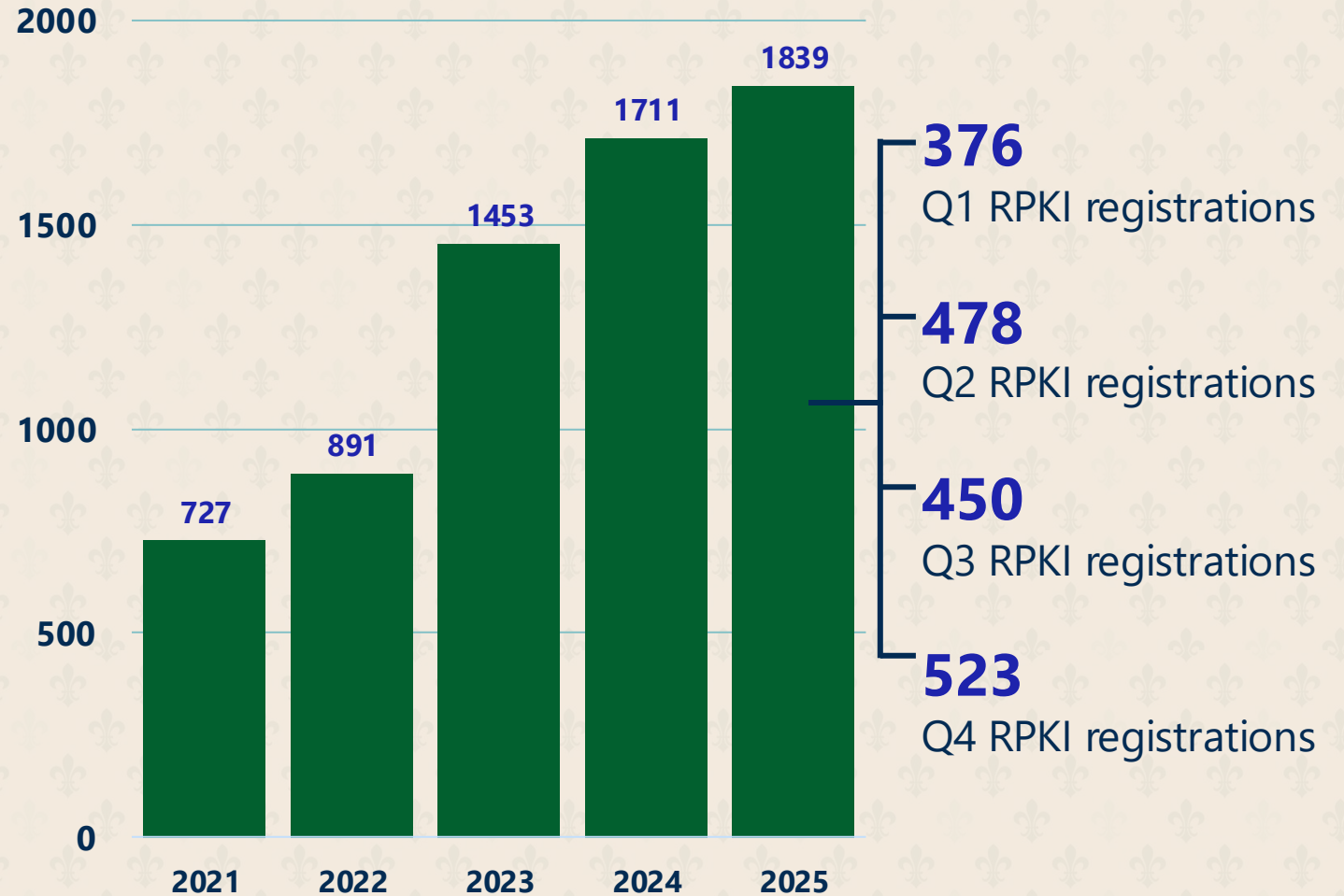


Routing Security Statistics

Community Outreach



ARIN Academy: Launched a new e-learning platform featuring courses on IPv6 and RPKI.

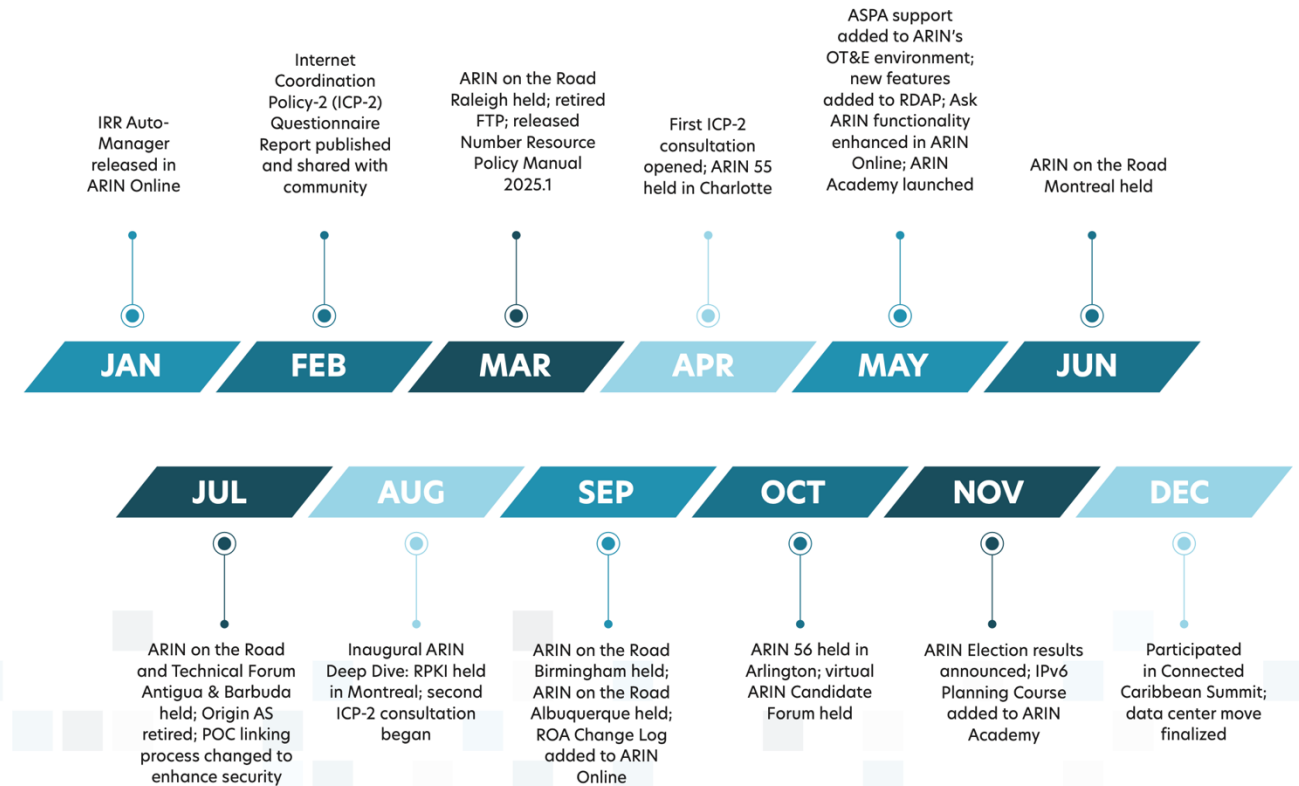

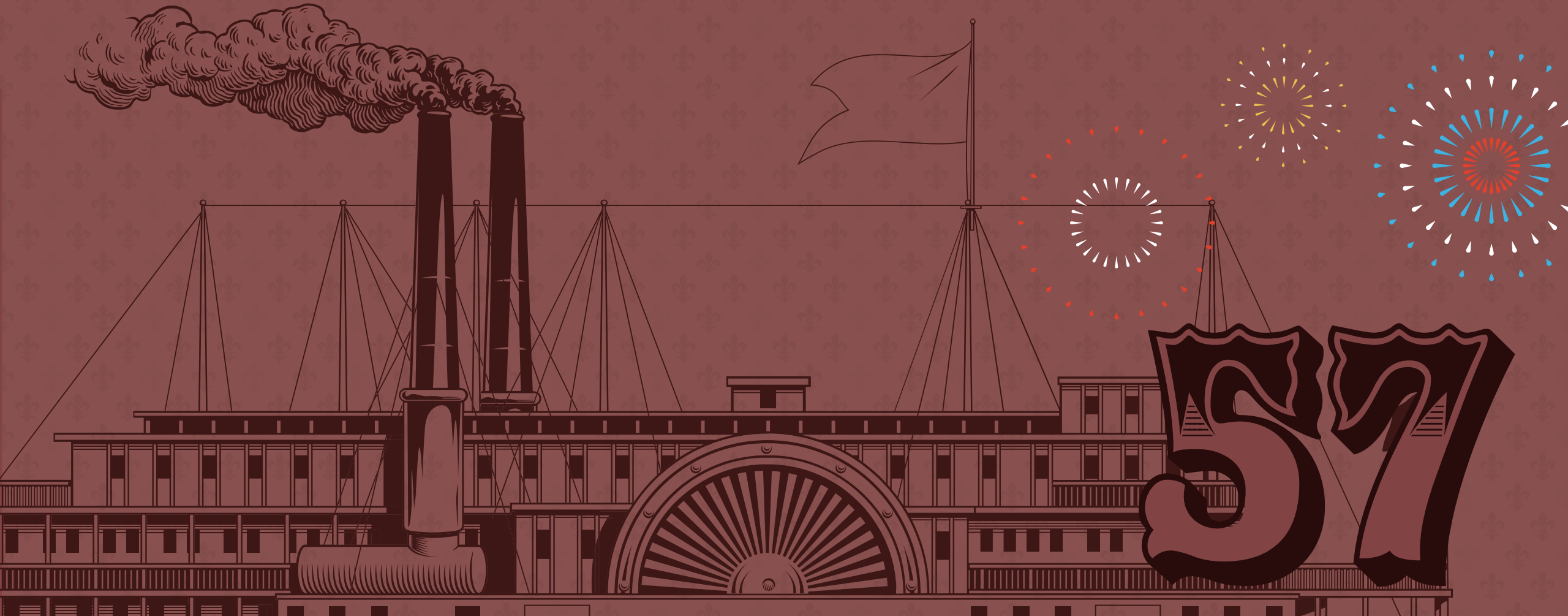
