Open and transparent process to document community decisions



Uses the Policy Development Process (PDP) and is documented in the Number Resource Policy Manual (NRPM)



ARIN Advisory Council helps shepherd proposals through the process

ARIN-2025-1

Clarify ISP and LIR
Definitions and References
to Address Ambiguity in
NRPM Text

- Current policies use the terms ISP and LIR somewhat interchangeably which can be confusing.
- Clearly defines ISP and LIR, and updates the policy manual to reference LIR, where appropriate.



ARIN-2025-3

Change Section 9 Out Of
Region Use Minimum
Criteria

- /22 requirement for out of region use harms smaller organizations that have less than a /22 in region but require some out of region use.
- Reduces the requirement down to a /24



ARIN-2025-6

Fix Formula in 6.5.2.1c.

- Make a correction to the formula that in section 6 describing maximum initial allocation size for ISP allocations.
- Definition for “Provider Assignment Unit” requires updating to “Allocation” to align with current practice.



ARIN-2025-7

Make Policy in 6.5.8.2
Match the Examples

- Clarify the requirements for initial allocation size for End-user allocations.
- End-users with a single site justify a single IPv6 /48.



ARIN-2025-8

Reserve 4.10 space for In-Region Use

Intends to codify current implementation of section "4.10. Dedicated IPv4 Allocation to Facilitate IPv6 Deployment" for use only within the ARIN region.



ARIN-2026-1

Taking IP To Other Planets
(TIPTOP)

- Developed jointly with the IETF TIPTOP working group
- Establishes a framework for extraterrestrial networking.

Making ARIN Meetings a Safe Place for Everyone

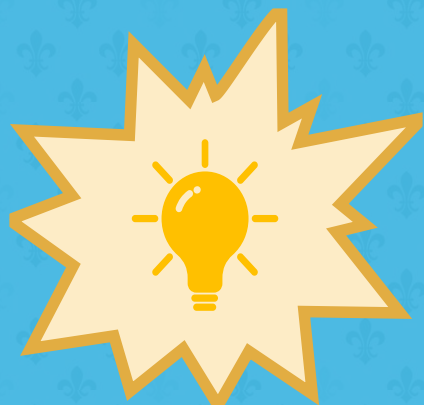

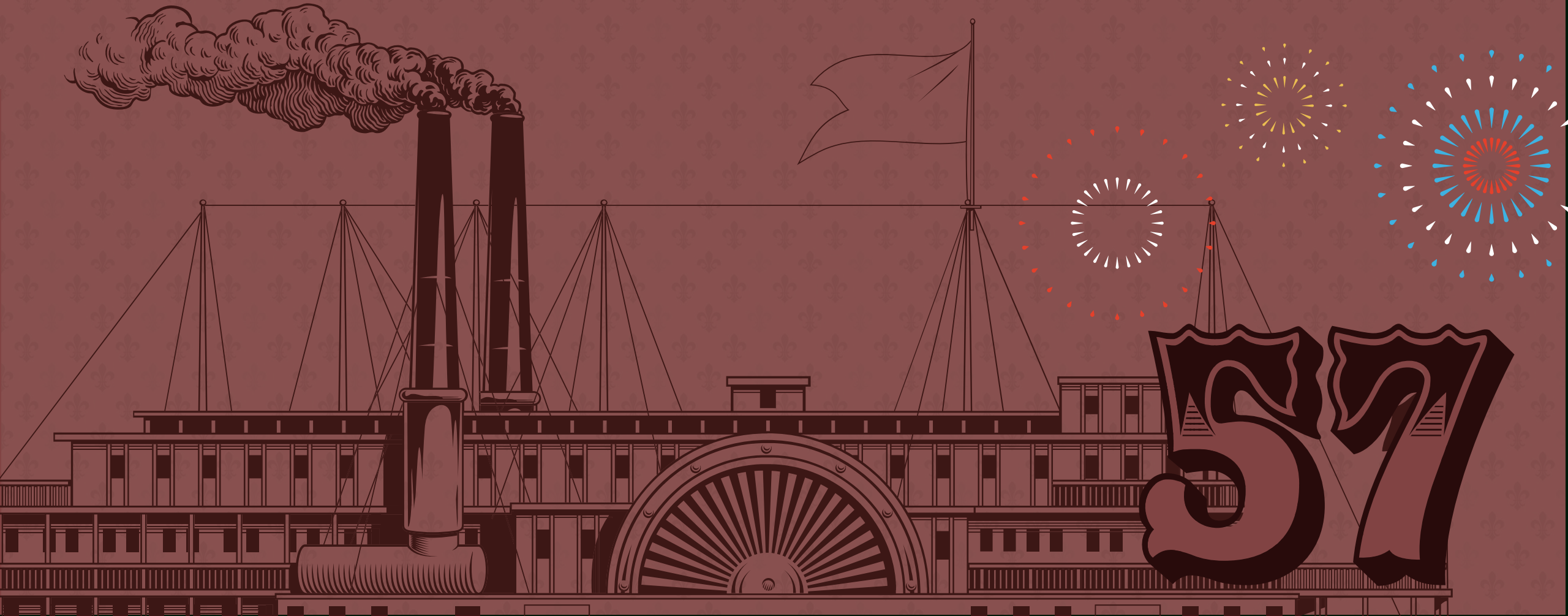
