# IPv6 Registration Fees

- Current Fee Schedule for IPv6
  - Annual subscription fee of \$2,500 US charged to organizations approved for receiving the standard /35 initial IPv6 allocation
- There has been an ongoing discussion about what fees ARIN should charge for IPv6
- ARIN does not want to discourage the registration of IPv6 or hinder the growth of IPv6 networks



# IPv6 Registration Fees

- It has been suggested ARIN change IPv6 fee policy
  - Current ARIN IPv4 subscribers/members would not pay a registration fee for their initial IPv6 (/35) allocation
  - For a one or two year period
- This temporary fee change may allow more organizations to request IPv6 address space
- Should ARIN make a change to its existing IPv6 fee structure?
