History

- Several resource holders have expressed discomfort with the existing amnesty policy.
- Ambiguity in the existing policy creates an impression that returning space may require full return and renumbering into a new block.

Intent

- Provide a clear intent to make resource return as painless as possible.
- Give staff and resource holders better tools to work together on resource returns.
- Attempts to reduce disincentives for legacy holders to sign RSA.

Highlights

- No penalties for returns.
- Minimize renumbering required for returns or aggregation.
- Encourages BoT to adopt incentives for returns.
- Allows staff to negotiate appropriate timeframes for return of address space.

Highlights (cont'd)

- Allows staff to reject transactions which are not in the best interests of the community.
- Requires RSA for any new resource issued.
- Requires annual contact/verification regardless of RSA.

Staff Concerns

- Complexity of revised language
- Other concerns addressed by revisions

Concerns Addressed by Revisions

- Potential for abuse by repetitive exercise of policy
- Lack of time limits on return
