

## Allocation of IPv4 Blocks to RIRs Summary

- RIRs would return all recovered IPv4 space to the IANA to form a new free pool.
- When the IANA /8s are gone, then the IANA to RIR allocation policy would change. RIRs could apply for 1/10<sup>th</sup> of the IANA free pool once every 6 months.



- Need = <50% of

current allocation unit

Global scheduling, not local needs based Presumes RIRs will continue to recover and return Every RIR receives <u>same</u> allocation regardless of Need or Recovery Success
