Problem Statement

- This proposal is a NRPM clean-up
- Author observes that 7.1 attempts to dictate operational practice for managing inaddr.arpa which oughtn't be in the NRPM
- 7.1 is silent on ip6.arpa, which works fine, thus demonstrating that ARIN staff's technical judgement on implementation is sufficient

• Remove 7.1 in its entirety.

- Generally, operational practice does not go in the NRPM. Is there something special about in-addr.arpa that makes it different?
- If so, does that extend to ip6.arpa?
