The American Registry for Internet Numbers (ARIN) is seeking individuals interested in joining its Advisory Council.

ARIN Policy Development

All policies governing the management of Internet number resources (IPv4, IPv6, and Autonomous System Numbers) in the ARIN region are developed by and for the ARIN community using the Policy Development Process (PDP).

Policy development is an open and transparent process coordinated by a team of 15 community volunteers who serve on the ARIN Advisory Council (AC).

The Role of the Advisory Council

The AC facilitates communication within the community regarding proposed changes to Internet number resource policy, guides proposals and policies through the PDP, and advances community consensus policies to the Board of Trustees for ratification.

The AC also advises the Board of Trustees on Internet number resource policy and related matters.

- Regional diversity to reflect the needs of the broader ARIN community
- Commitment to collaborative, responsible Internet stewardship
