Amendment to Article VI Section 5, Quorum., and Article VIII Section 5, Quorum., to clarify that absentee voting and voting by proxy are not allowed.

a. Current Text

Article VI, Section 5. Quorum. A majority of the Trustees shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Unless otherwise stated in these Bylaws, decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be made by the concurrence of a majority of members of the Board of Trustees present and voting. If at any meeting there is no quorum present, the Board must not transact business.

Article VIII, Section 5. Quorum. A majority of the Advisory Council members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Unless otherwise stated in these Bylaws, decisions of the Advisory Council shall be made by the concurrence of a majority of members present and voting. If at any meeting there is no quorum present, the Advisory Council must not transact business.

a. Revised Text

Article VI, Section 5. Quorum. A majority of the Trustees shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. Unless otherwise stated in these Bylaws, dDecisions of the Board of Trustees shall be made by the concurrence of a majority of members of the Board of Trustees present and voting.
