A little history

- Exchange is over 10 years old
- Formed as an OHSU / PSU partnership
- Originally could have allowed IP transit to be sold via the exchange, though I don't think this was ever done
- At one time had dark fiber to ViaWest/Easystreet and provided transport on those links
- Was tied up with PREN which was part of I2
- In more recent years, has also become the interconnect point for Oregon Health Network providers



What is happening?

- OHSU handing over all assets to new non-profit
 - Will allow volunteers to manage it eliminate FTE costs
 - Pittock will donate space/power/cross-connects
 - Contracts no longer required to be a member
 - Board is now elected by members
 - Now able to have a capital reserve fund

 - Public Benefit Corporation With Members
 - Need articles of incorporation (modified the SIX ones for Oregon)
 - Kathleen Bertero of Jordan Ramis PC did the paperwork for us



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NORTHWEST ACCESS EXCHANGE, INC.

The undersigned individual, 18 years of age or older, acting as incorporator under the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1 NAME AND DURATION

The name of the corporation is Northwest Access Exchange, Inc. (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE 2 DURATION

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE 3 TYPE

The Corporation is a nonprofit, public benefit corporation, organized under the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Act.

BYLAWS OF NORTHWEST ACCESS EXCHANGE, INC.

ARTICLE 1. NAME AND OPERATION

- 1.1 <u>Name</u>. The name of this corporation is Northwest Access Exchange, Inc. ("Corporation"). The Corporation may file for and do business under an assumed business name.
- 1.2 <u>Operation</u>. The Corporation shall be operated as a public benefit nonprofit corporation under the provisions of the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Act (the "Act").

ARTICLE 2. OFFICES

The principal office of the Corporation shall be located at its principal place of business or such other place as the Board of Directors of the Corporation ("Board") may designate. The Corporation may have such other offices, either within or without the State of Oregon, as the Board may designate or as the business of the Corporation may require from time to time.

Pricing Structure

- 1 gig ports are FREE
 - Used to be \$395/mo
 - No need to provide optic even
 - 850nm MMF, 1310nm SMF, CAT5 in stock
- 10 gig ports are \$295/mo
 - No need to provide optic even
 - 1310 nm SMF optics in stock
- Custom Optics allowed (Long-Reach, CWDM, DWDM)
 - You just have to pay for them, or provide them, and provide for sparing model as desired
 - SFP+ Form Factor, Juniper EX Compatible



Timeline

- Official asset transfer set for December 31st
- Volunteers already jointly administering the fabric with OHSU / PSU
- New org starts billing Jan 1
 - Current members please keep paying OHSU until then
 - New NWAX org gets all funds in OHSU account as of that date
- Accepting new members immediately
 - New 10g members not billed till January



Ops Update

- The fabric is fundamentally a single EX4500 at this time
 - 48 usable 1/10g ports (~41 connected members)
- All 100 meg members upgraded to gig direct off EX4500
 - Two Cisco 3550's eliminated from the fabric
- Have moved all but two members off OHSU MX-480
 - Last two moving very soon upon arrival of new optics
- Have upgraded code on fabric
 - Latest jtac recommended release
- Port Security Mac Limiting now enabled
 - Loop prevention mechanism



To do list

- Website needs updated badly
 - Please ignore most of what is on there help wanted
- Need new monitoring / graphing system
 - In progress looking at IXP Manager among other things
- Need to physically separate NWAX and OHSU equipment
 - One or the other needs to migrate to separate cabinets
- Need more SMF cable to MMR new tie cable
- Need additional switching capacity
 - Spectrum Networks has offered to donate two 10g Arista switches
 - One 48 port and one 24 port will be available once taken out of current service
