### **NRPM Working Group Charter**

1.0 Purpose

The Number Resource Policy Manual Working Group is responsible for reviewing the then current iteration of the Number Resource Policy Manual with the goal of clarification and simplification of Internet number resource policy and recommending relevant updates in the form of Policy Proposals submitted through the ARIN Policy Development Process.

# **Completed Work**

### Highlights of Completed Work

- ARIN-edit-2021-1
  - Addressed the lack of formal definition for ASN
  - Correct inconsistent ASN language in Section 8
    - De-obfuscated the existence of ASN-only transactions
    - Aligned with ARIN staff practice

#### • ARIN-edit-2020-9

- Originally a larger scope for inter-related portions of sections 1, 4, 6 and 8
- Community discussions steered the Shepherds & WG away from an omnibus
- Trimmed down to clarifications to 8.2 and 8.4

# Work Underway

### Work Underway

#### • Prop 305

- Section 2 Cleanup
- Led by Chris Tacit
- Meant to be editorial in nature
- More proposals will follow to avoid an omnibus

#### • Prop 307

- Remove barrier to BGP uptake
- Led by Rob Seastrom
- Intention is to make initial ASN easy to obtain
- The current policies around ASN issuance were conservative in nature
- With industry adoption of support for 4-byte ASNs this policy can be liberalized
