# Advisory Council Members



“The Policy Development Process charges the member-elected ARIN Advisory Council (AC) as the primary facilitators of the process”

## The Advisory Council:

- Works with proposal authors to ensure that they have valid problem statements and are within the scope of ARIN's Policy Development Process (PDP)
- Develops Draft Policies by gathering input and presenting them as works in progress to the community
- Recommends Draft Policies that are:
  - Fair and impartial
  - Technically sound
  - Supported by community
- Initiates Last Call and reviews final comments
- Recommend to the Board of Trustees for adoption

# Policy Work since ARIN 39



- Sent to the Board of Trustees for Adoption:
  - ARIN-2016-3: Alternative simplified criteria for justifying small IPv4 transfers (Implemented 8 August)
  - ARIN-2016-9: Streamline Merger & Acquisition Transfers (Implemented 8 August)
- Abandoned:
  - ARIN-2016-8: Removal of Indirect POC Validation Requirement (10 April)
  - ARIN-2017-1: Clarify Slow Start for Transfers (20 June)
  - ARIN-2017-2: Removal of Community Networks (17 August)
  - ARIN-2017-7: Retire Obsolete Section 4 from the NRPM (17 August)

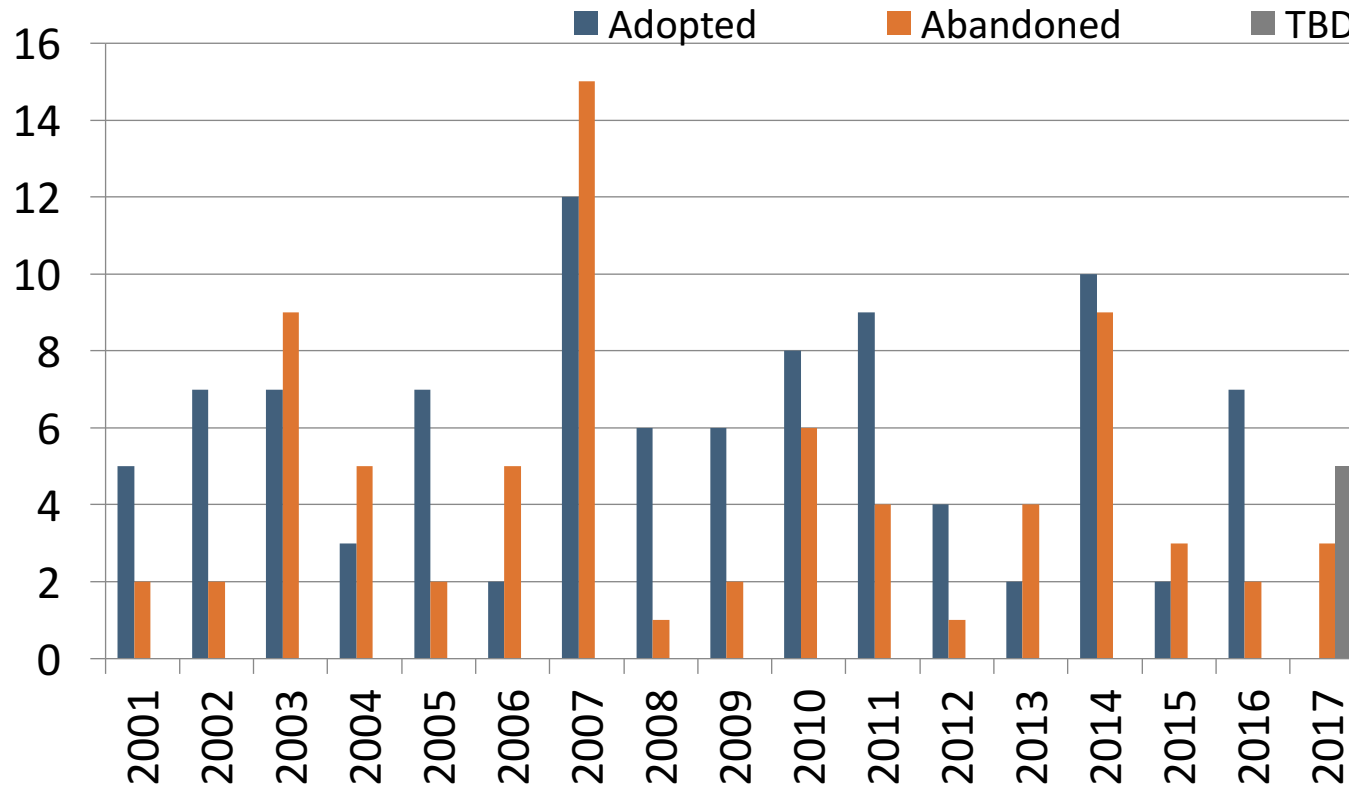
Current Docket – Four Draft Policies, One Recommended Draft Policy

## New Proposals since ARIN 39

- ARIN-prop-240: Equalization of Assignment Registration requirements between IPv4 and IPv6
  - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2017-5 (Retitled “Improved IPv6 Registration Requirements”)
- ARIN-prop-241: Improve Reciprocity Requirement for Inter-RIR Transfers
  - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2017-6
- ARIN-prop-242: Retire obsolete section 4 from the NRPM
  - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2017-7 (Abandoned 17 August)
- ARIN-prop-243: Amend the definition of Community Network
  - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2017-8
