

## ASO/AC Activities: Global Policy Management

(Global Policy Development)



- Each region has its own policy development process
  - All open, transparent, and bottom-up
- Global policy proposals are submitted in all 5 regions
- Each region follows its own process
- It then gets passed to the NRO for review
- And forwarded to the ICANN board

## ASO/AC Activities : Global Policy Management

- Policy Proposal Facilitators Team (PPFT) 2019 was appointed 1 member from each region
  - From ARIN, *Jason Schiller* was selected.
- There are currently no Global Policy Proposals



## ICANN Board Seat 10 Election

- The selected candidate will serve for a three-year term, which will begin at the conclusion of the ICANN Annual General Assembly during the ICANN 66 Meeting, scheduled from 2-7 November 2019 in Montréal, Canada.
- Seat 10 is currently served by Asia Pacific representative Maemura Akinori.
- **Nominations**  
Nominations closed on Friday, 30 November 2018 at 23:59 UTC. The following candidates were nominated:
  - **Dmitry Burkov**
  - **Akinori Maemura**
  - **Andile Ngcaba – Nomination withdrawn on 18 February 2019.**

## ICANN Board Seat 10 Election

### Important Dates

- **Nomination Phase:** 15 September 2018 – 30 November 2018
- **Comment Phase:** 1 December 2018 – 15 January 2019
- **ICANN Due Diligence for nominated candidates:** 1 – 15 January 2019
- **Interview Phase:** 1 – 28 February 2019
- **Selection Phase (deliberation):** 1 February 2019 – 14 March 2019
- **Selection Phase (voting):** 15 – 21 March 2019
- **Announcement of selected candidate:** around 22 March 2019

- Evaluation of nominations by the ASO AC: **28 July – 7 August 2019**
- Voting period by the ASO AC: **7 August – 14 August 2019**
- Announcement of selected delegate: **15 August 2019**

### Extension of Deadline :

- Nomination period ends: 9 August 2019
- Evaluation of nominations by the ASO AC: 9 – 14 August 2019
- ASO AC Voting period 15 – 21 August 2019
- Announcement of selected delegate: 22 August 2019

### Run-Off Procedure:

- Start of Run Off eVote: **23 August 2019**
- End of Run Off eVote: **27 August 2019**
- Announcement of selected candidate: **28 August 2019**

### ADDRESS SUPPORTING ORGANIZATION (ASO)

The purpose of the Address Supporting Organization (ASO) is to review and develop recommendations on Internet Protocol (IP) address policy and to advise the ICANN Board. Fifteen volunteers, three from each of the five RIR communities, serve on the ASO Address Council (AC).

Under the [ICANN ASO Memorandum of Understanding](#), the ASO AC's responsibilities include:

1. Undertaking a role in the global policy development process;
2. Defining procedures for the selection of individuals to serve on the AC in consultation with the ICANN Board and the RIRs, and the roles assigned to the AC in such procedures. The ASO AC also reviews and recommends the ASO's number resource allocation policy, in conjunction with the RIRs;
3. Providing advice to the ICANN Board on number resource allocation policy, in conjunction with the RIRs.
