Clarification of Section 4.10 for Multiple
Discrete Networks**

Problem Summary

- In a nutshell, the current wording of 4.10 doesn't take Multiple Discrete Networks into account
 - Organizations that have such networks probably need separate blocks for transition as well

Proposed Solution

- Allow MDN organizations to apply for a transition block for each of their discrete networks
- Limit this to no more a total of 8 /24s per six month period

PPML Summary

- Generally favorable (4 in favor, 1 expression of opposition)
- Opposition: “IPv6 connectivity is required, sites can use IPv6 to tunnel to the central NAT point”
