# Staff and Legal Review



- Summary (Staff Understanding)
  - This Draft Policy would adjust initial allocation allowance to a /22 from a /21, where previous language showed possible conflict with waitlist language specifying a /22 maximum.

# Staff and Legal Review



#### • Staff Comments

- ARIN staff understands this policy to harmonize sections of the ARIN Number Resource Policy Manual (NRPM) and eliminate contradictions and confusion.
- Specifically the largest allocation that ARIN is authorized to distribute by policy is a /22.
- This policy is welcomed by staff for the clarification that it provides.
- ARIN will continue to allow up to a /22 as the maximum allocation distributed per policy.

# Staff and Legal Review



- •Legal Assessment
  - The policy does not create a material legal issue.
- Resource Impact
  - Minimal could be implemented within three months.
  - The following would be needed in order to implement:
    - Staff training
    - Updated guidelines and internal procedures
    - Standard documentation updates

#### Policy Goals



 Correct discrepancy between Section 4.2.2 (Initial Allocation To ISPs) and 4.1.8 Waitlist Policy as to size of initial allocations

•Change initial allocation size in 4.2.2 from /21 to /22



### Current Language



#### • 4.2.2. Initial Allocation to ISPs

• All ISP organizations without direct assignments or allocations from ARIN qualify for an initial allocation of up to a /21, subject to ARIN's minimum allocation size.

#### Proposed Language



#### • 4.2.2. Initial Allocation to ISPs

• All ISP organizations without direct assignments or allocations from ARIN qualify for an initial allocation of up to a /22, subject to ARIN's minimum allocation size.



#### Notes on Proposal



- •PPML feedback has been positive, largely seeing this as a no-op, as all current allocations from ARIN are via 4.1.8.
- No concerns raised about negative impact on community members
