

Draft Policy ARIN-2020-8: Clarify and Update 4.2.1.2 Annual Renewal Fee Joe Provo and Owen DeLong



Problem Statement

- The January 2020 Policy Experience Report highlighted that the existing language in Section 4.2.1.2 "Annual Renewal" references fees.
- Fees are not considered a member qualification criteria.
- Since fees aren't referenced elsewhere in community policy, the wording was reviewed by the Policy Experience Working Group.



Policy Statement

- Given that the Registration Services Agreement (RSA) already contains language regarding fees, the Policy Experience Working Group recommends removing the last two sentences referencing fees from Section 4.2.1.2.
- The intent of the current wording is accomplished by the existing RSA.



Draft Text

4.2.1.2. Annual Renewal

An annual fee for registered space is due by the anniversary date of the ISP's first allocation from ARIN. ISPs should take care to ensure that their annual renewal payment is made by their anniversary due date in accordance with the Registration Services Agreement. If not paid by the anniversary date, the oked. Please review dress space may Renewal/Maintenance Fees Page for more

PPML Feedback

In favor:

"In light of this, shouldn't the entire section be removed?"

"I believe Section 4.2.1.2 should be completely removed."

"Nevertheless, I think it is a good idea to add a definition of the term Registration Services Agreement and the acronym RSA to section 2.

Against:

"I don't see a potential problem in keeping that part of the text where it is."

Suggested New Text

Eliminate 4.2.1.2. entirely. Add:

2.X Registration Services Agreement (RSA)

Number resources allocated or assigned by ARIN under these policies are subject to a Registration Services Agreement (RSA) between ARIN and the resource holder. This agreement covers terms, rights, responsibilities and conditions of service; failure to adhere to the RSA may result in revocation of number resources.
