

## Adopted Policy ARIN-2020-2

Reinstatement of Organizations Removed from Waitlist by Implementation of ARIN-2019-16



#### **Policy Statement**

Add section 4.1.8.3 (temporary language in the NRPM to remain until the policy objective is achieved):

Restoring organizations to the waitlist

ARIN will restore organizations that were removed from the waitlist at the adoption of ARIN-2019-16 to their previous position if their total holdings of IPv4 address space amounts to a /18 or less. The maximum size aggregate that a reinstated organization may qualify for is a /22.

All restored organizations extend their 2 year approval by [number of months between July 2019 and implementation of new policy]. Any requests met through a transfer will be considered fulfilled and removed from the waiting list.



#### History

- Proposal (ARIN-prop-282): 10 January 2020
- Draft Policy: 24 March 2020
- <u>Recommended Draft Policy</u>: 22 September 2020
- Last Call: 20 October 2020
- Reverted to Draft Policy: 6 January 2021
- <u>Petitioned for Board of Trustees Review as Recommended Draft</u> <u>Policy</u>: 16 January 2021
- Adopted by Board of Trustees: 4 March 2021
- Implemented: 16 March 2021



#### Implementation

Criteria for extension and /22 distribution:

- Waitlist request pending available space when ARIN-2019-16 was implemented (10 July 2019)
- Request removed as part of ARIN-2019-16 implementation
- Currently holding a /18 or less of v4 space

Staff assessment: 17 eligible organizations when ARIN-2020-2 was adopted



#### Implementation, continued.

Distribution:

- 17 request tickets initiated by ARIN staff
- 17 requests filled
- Final request filled 3/23/2021

Temporary "Section 4.1.8.3." retired, new NRPM issued 16 March 2021.



#### Petitions in the Policy Development Process<sup>12</sup>

#### PDP Part Three, Section 2.4. Petition for Board of Trustees Consideration

Any member of the community may initiate a Board of Trustees Consideration Petition if they are dissatisfied with the Advisory Council's failure to act within the allotted time (60 days) to send a Recommended Draft Policy in last call to the Board of Trustees for consideration. A successful petition for Board of Trustees Consideration requires expressions of petition support from at least 25 different people from 25 different organizations. If successful, this petition will send the Recommended Draft Policy from last call to the Board of Trustees for consideration.
