- Resolution to establish an Ad-Hoc Group was adopted at the August 1999 meeting in Santiago.
- A Charter for the Ad-Hoc Group was endorsed by the ICANN Board at November 1999 meeting in Los Angeles.
- The Ad-Hoc Group should identify the key technology, commercial and economic drivers that will affect addressing and numbering in the Internet.
- The Ad-Hoc Group will work through a Public Comment Forum on the ICANN website.
- The ICANN Board has invited a small Editorial Group to coordinate the Forum.
