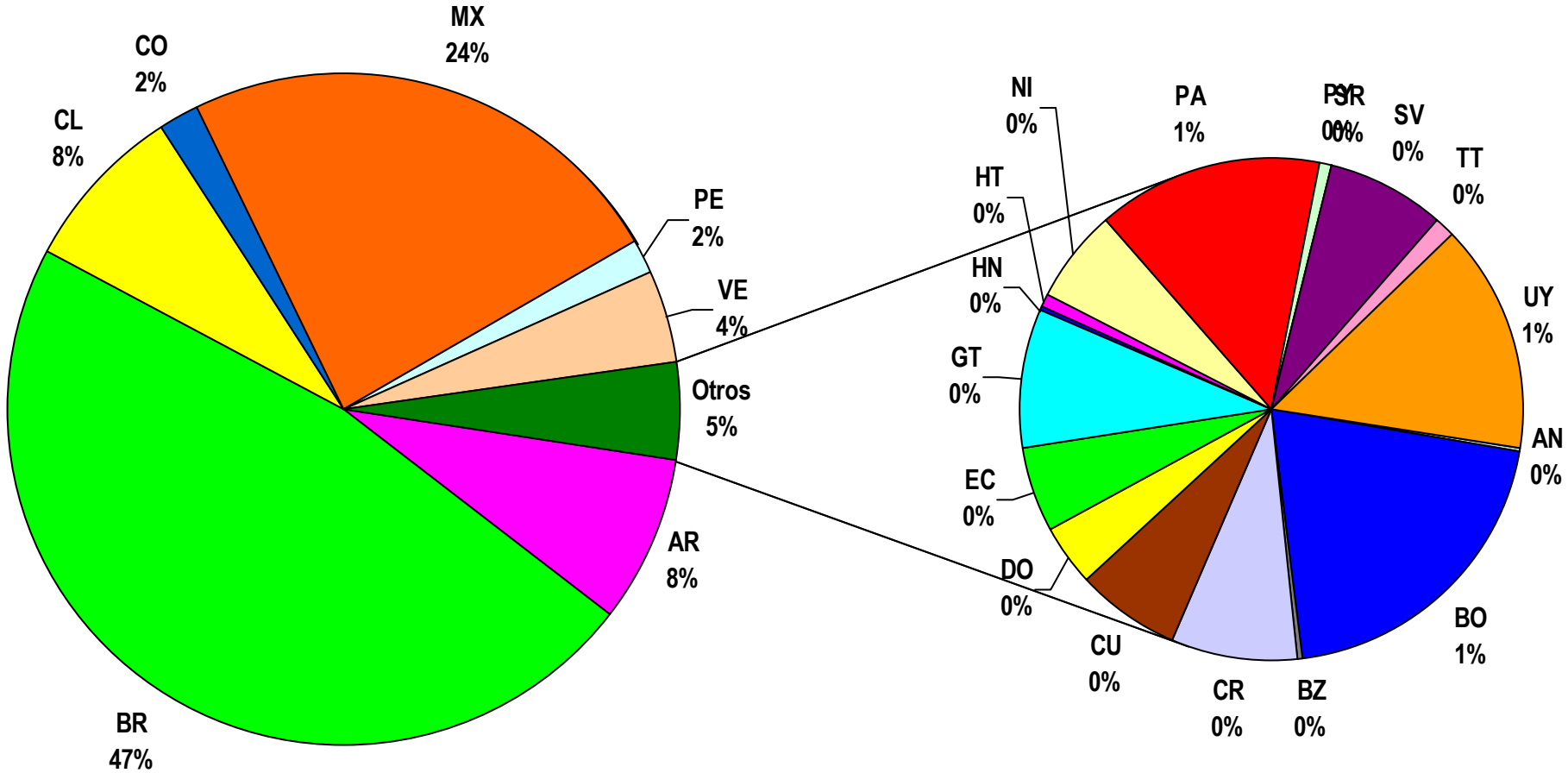

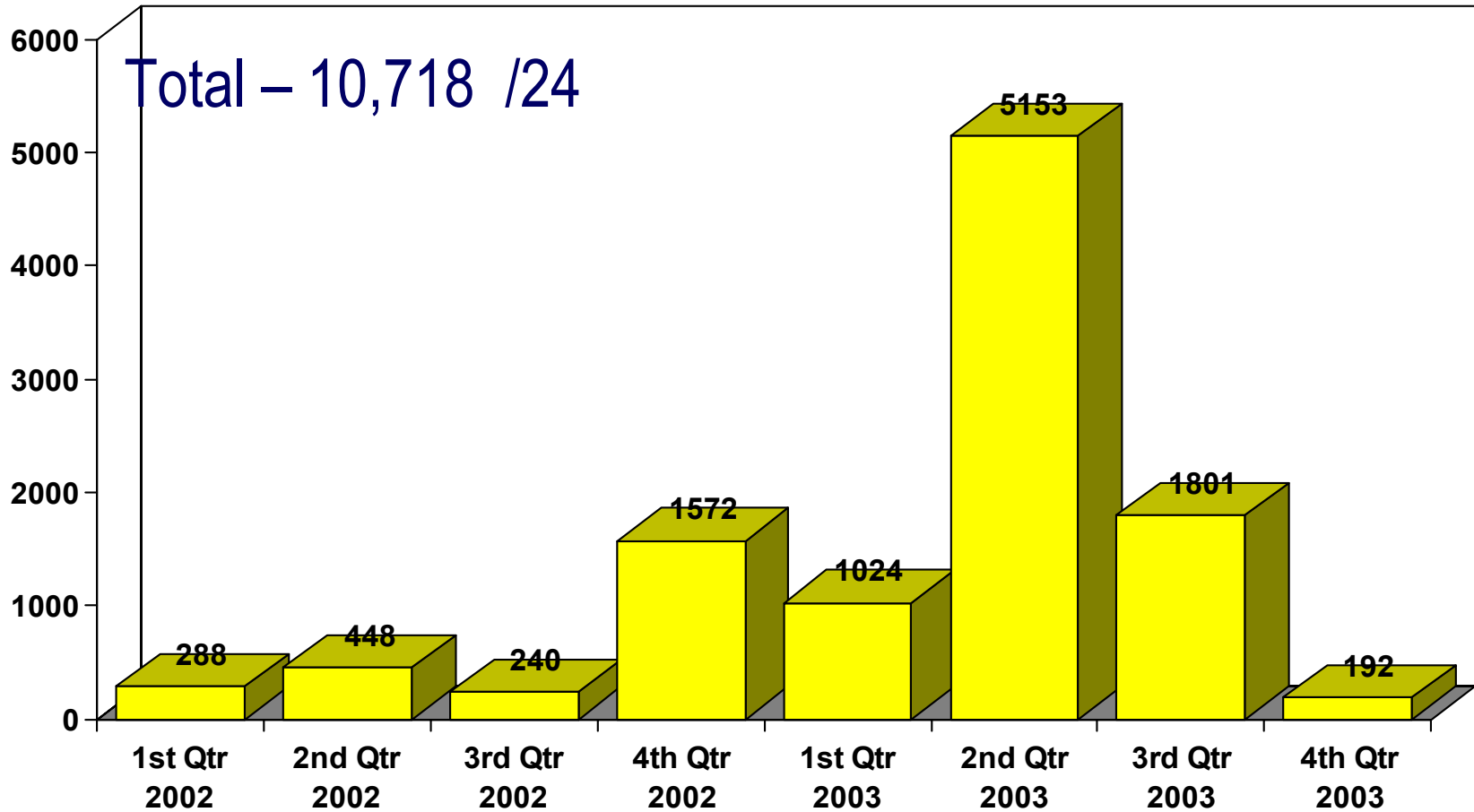
IPv4 DISTRIBUTION by COUNTRY

IPv4 /24 ALLOCATED PER QUARTER

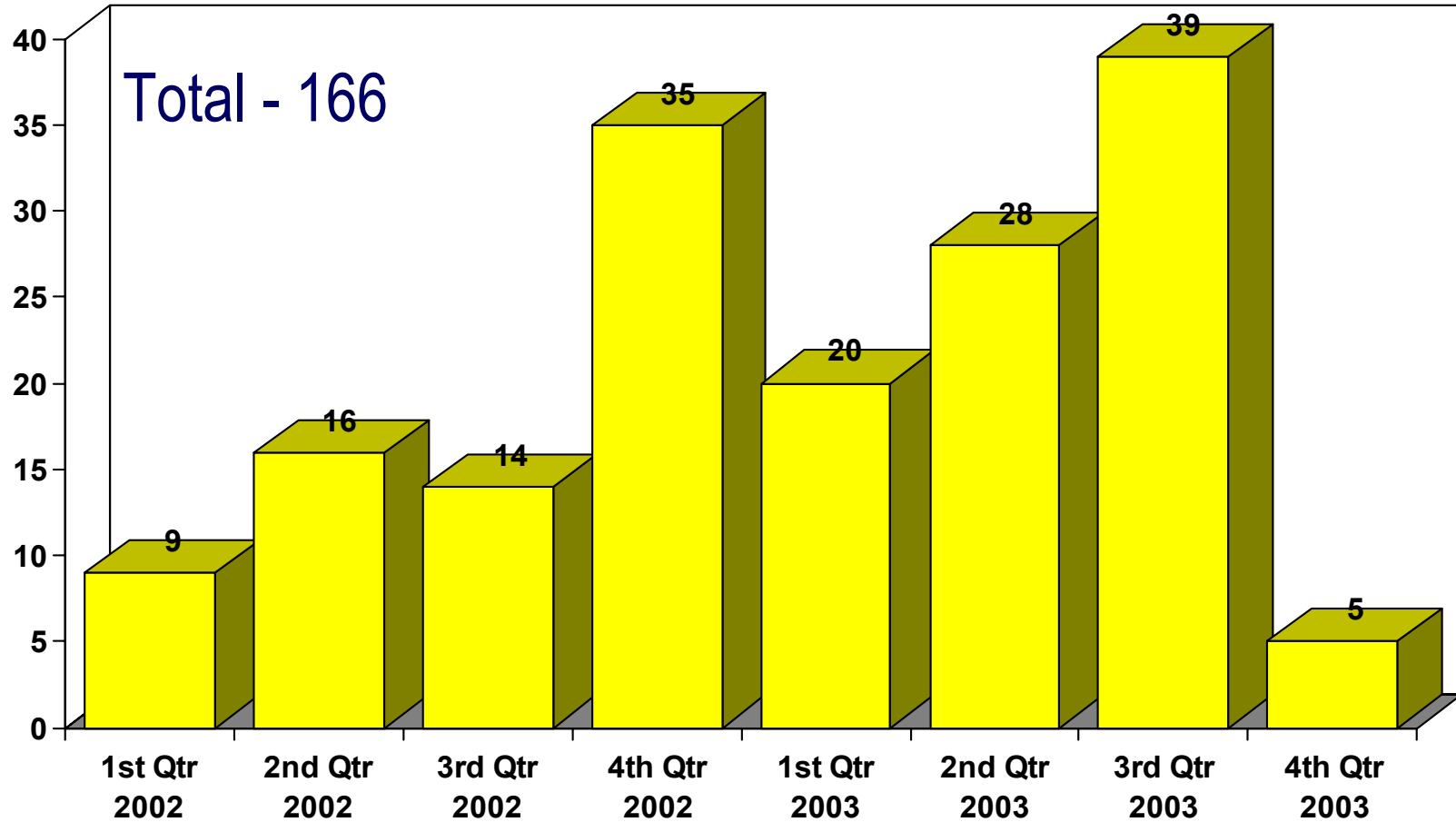

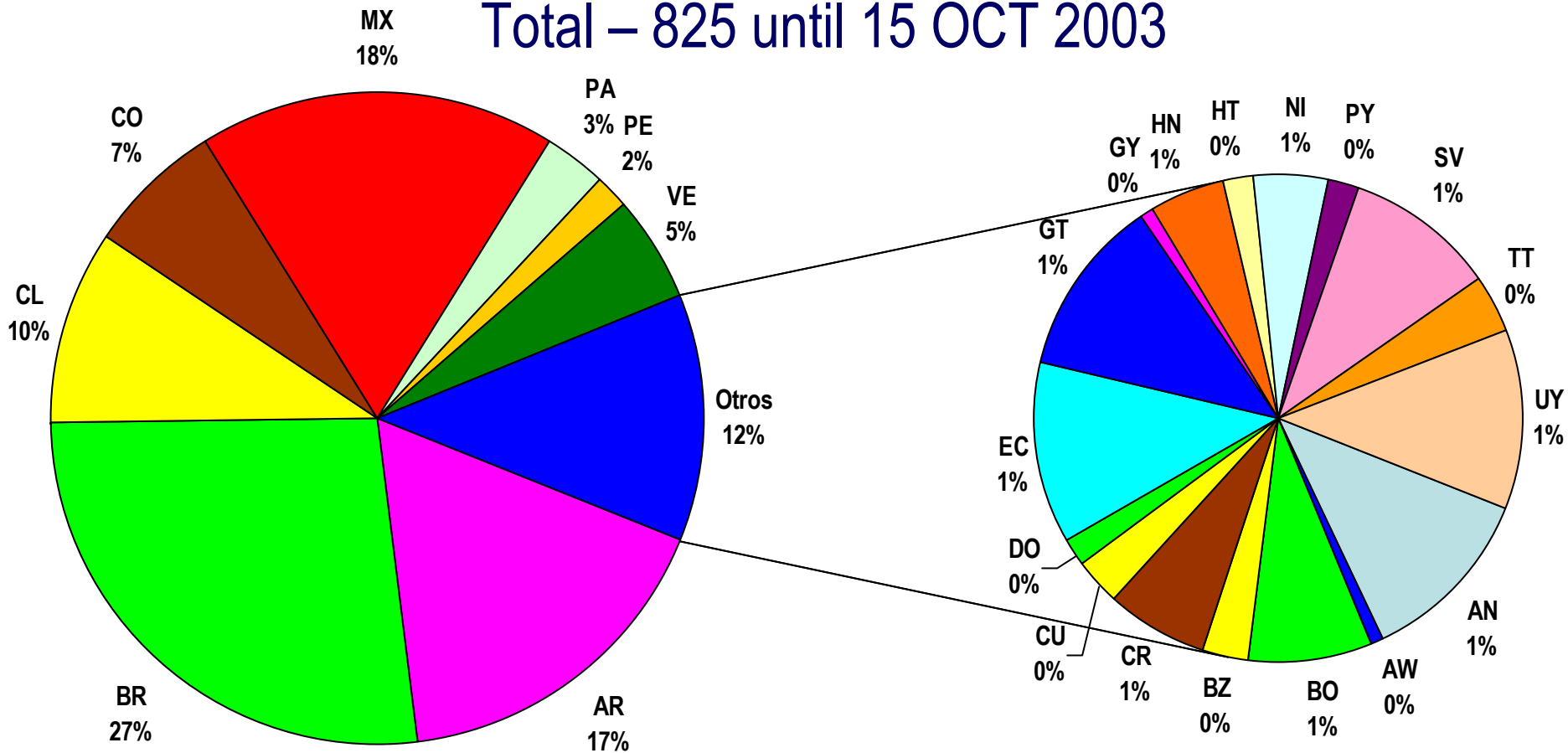
IPv4 ALLOCATIONS PER QUARTER

ASN DISTRIBUTION by COUNTRY

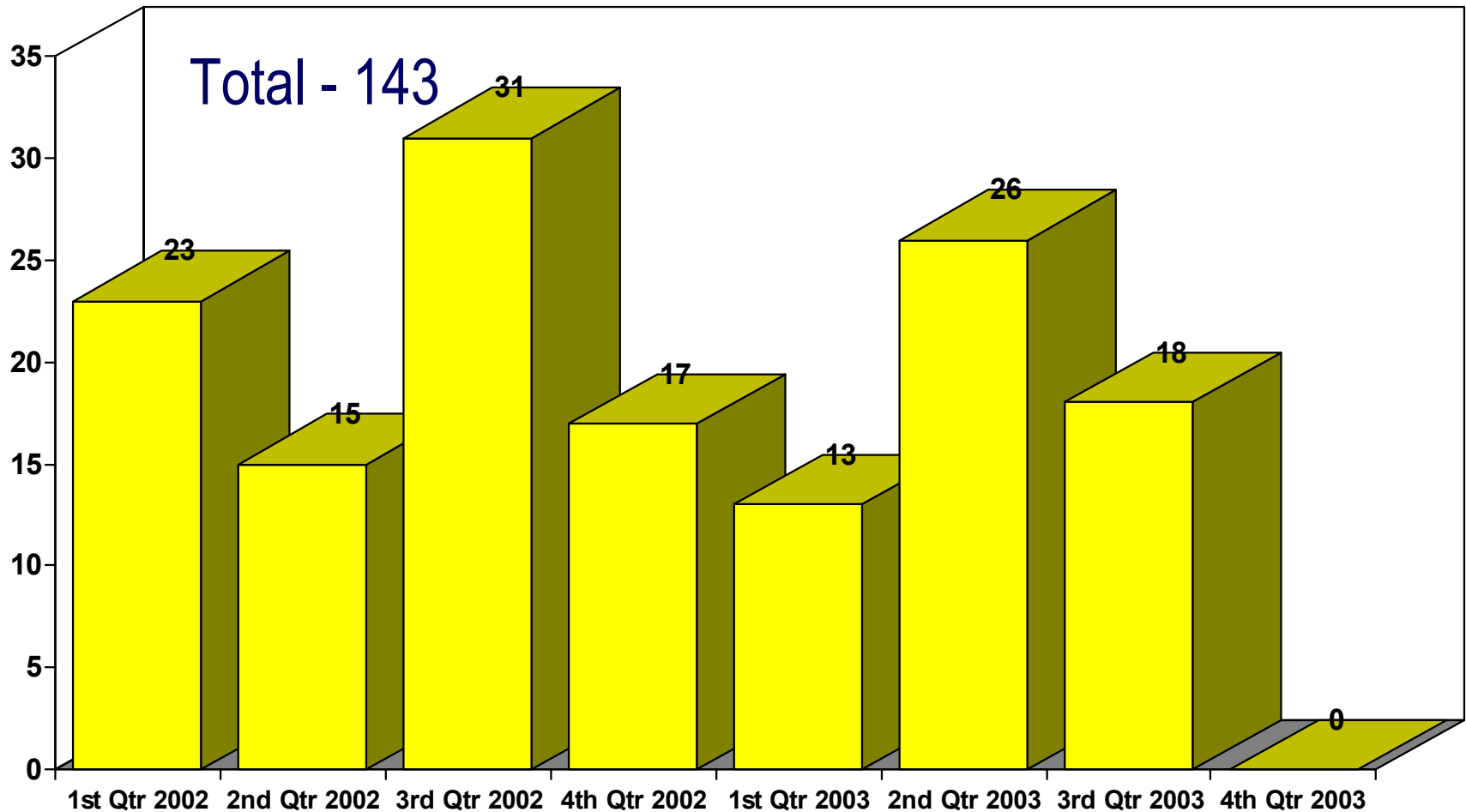

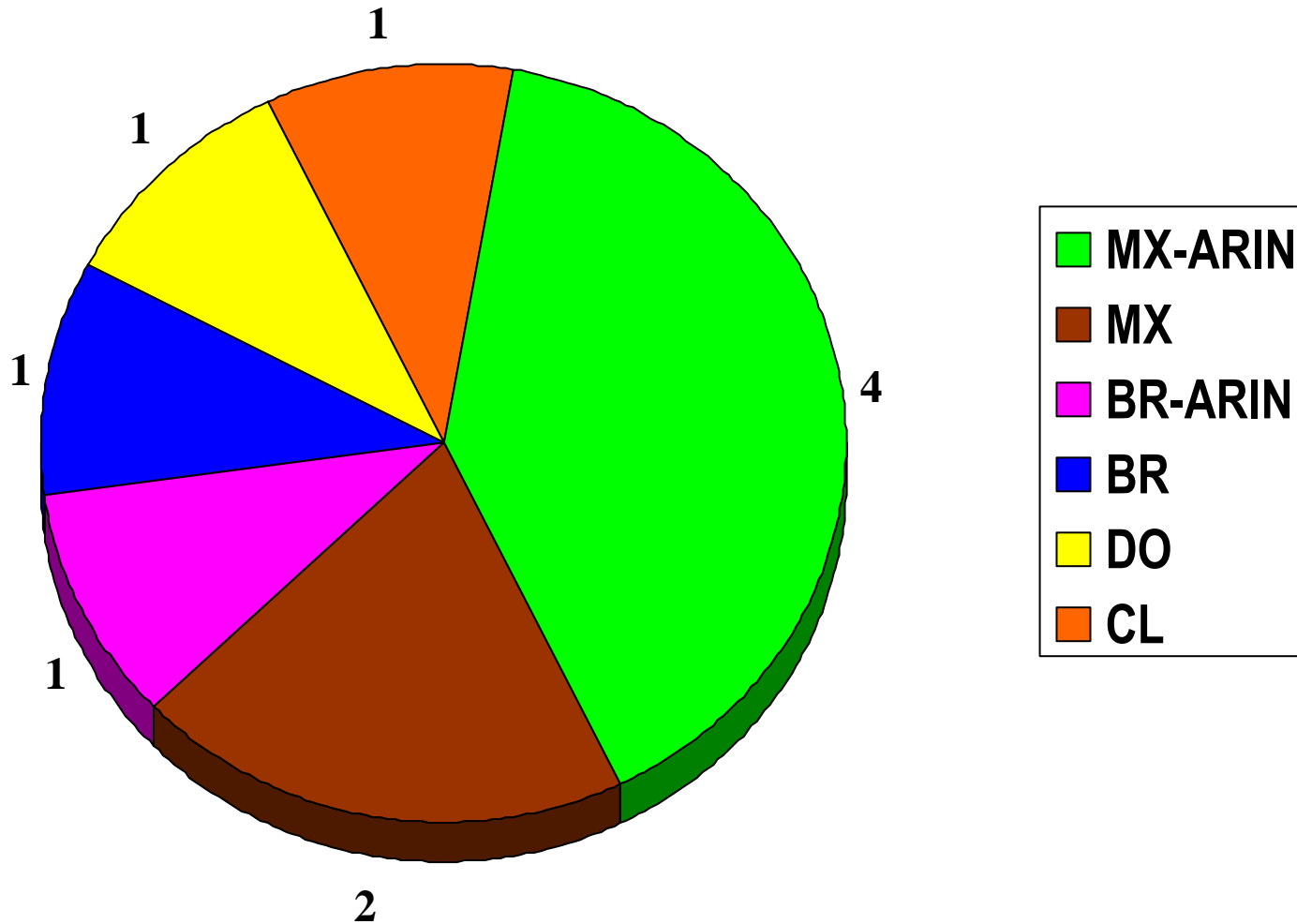


ASN ASSIGNMENT PER QUARTER

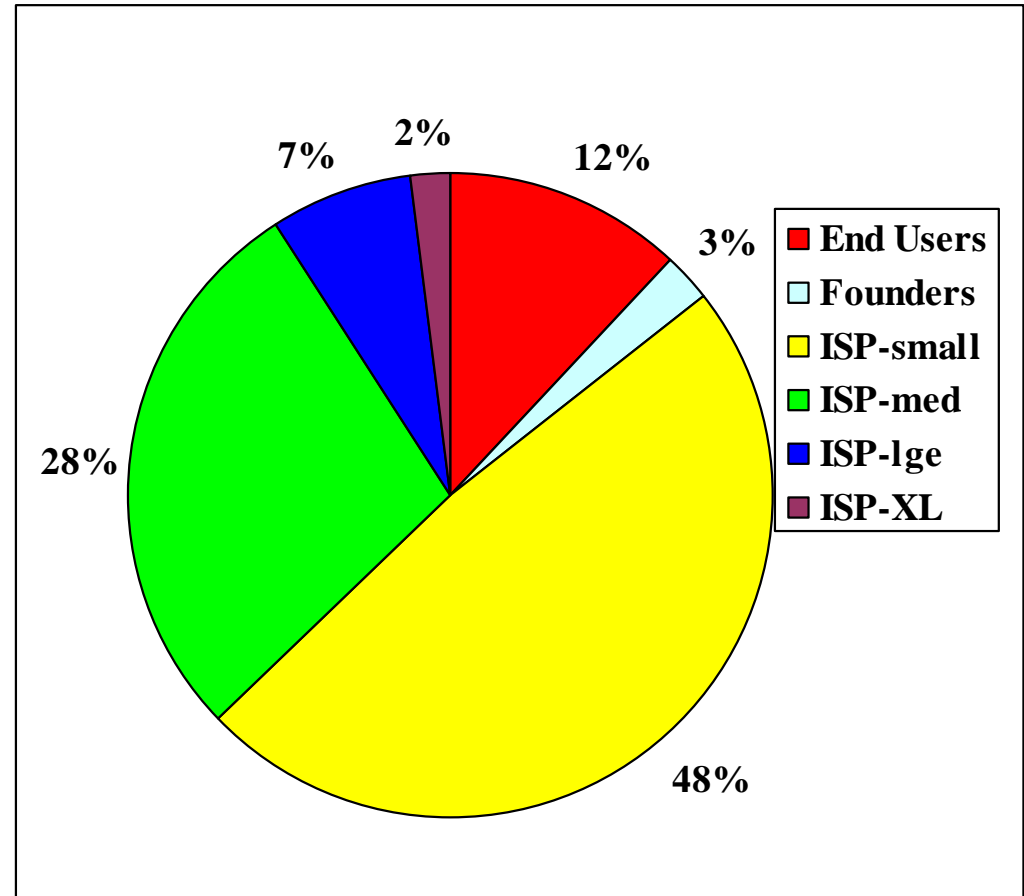

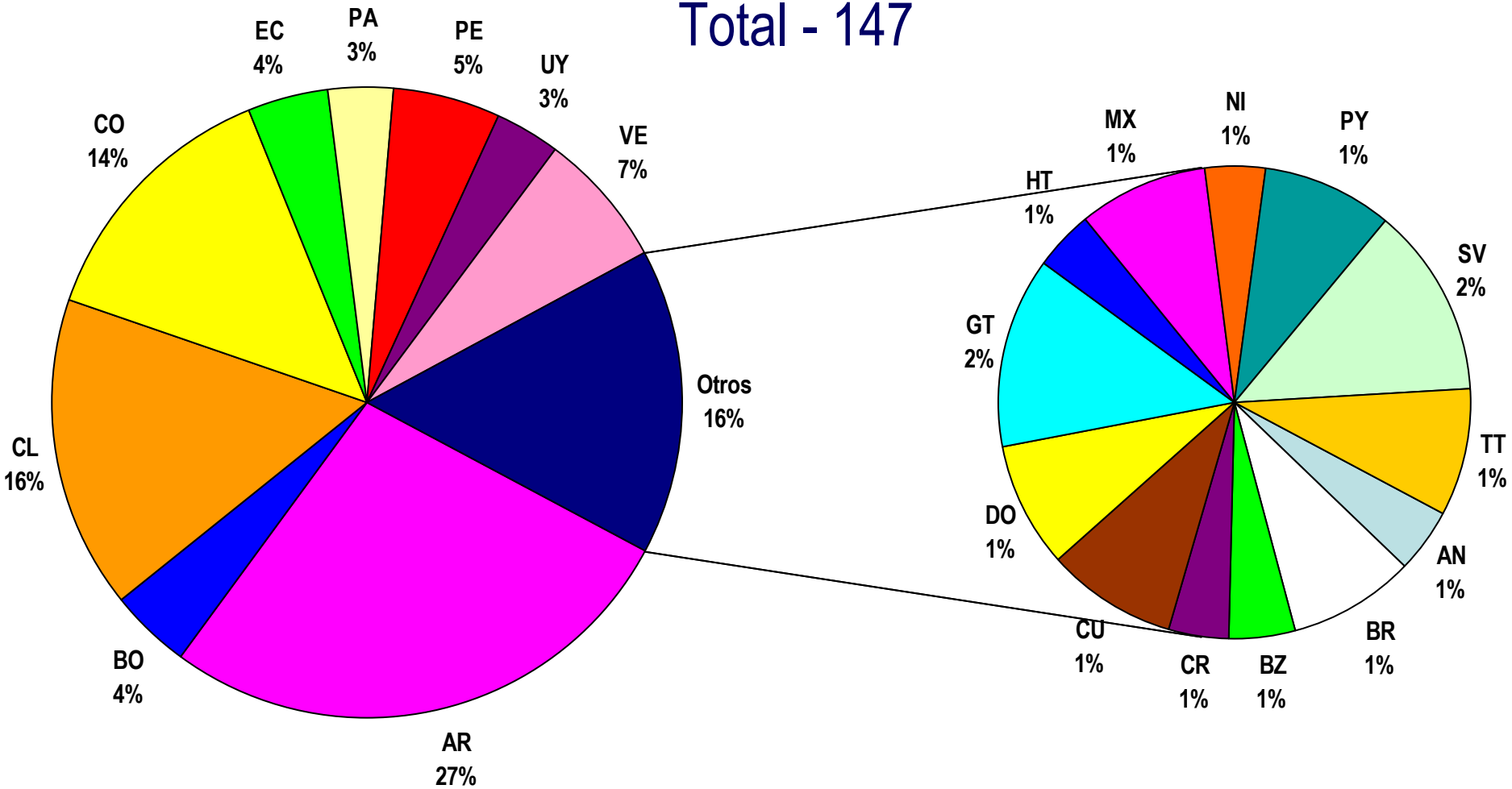

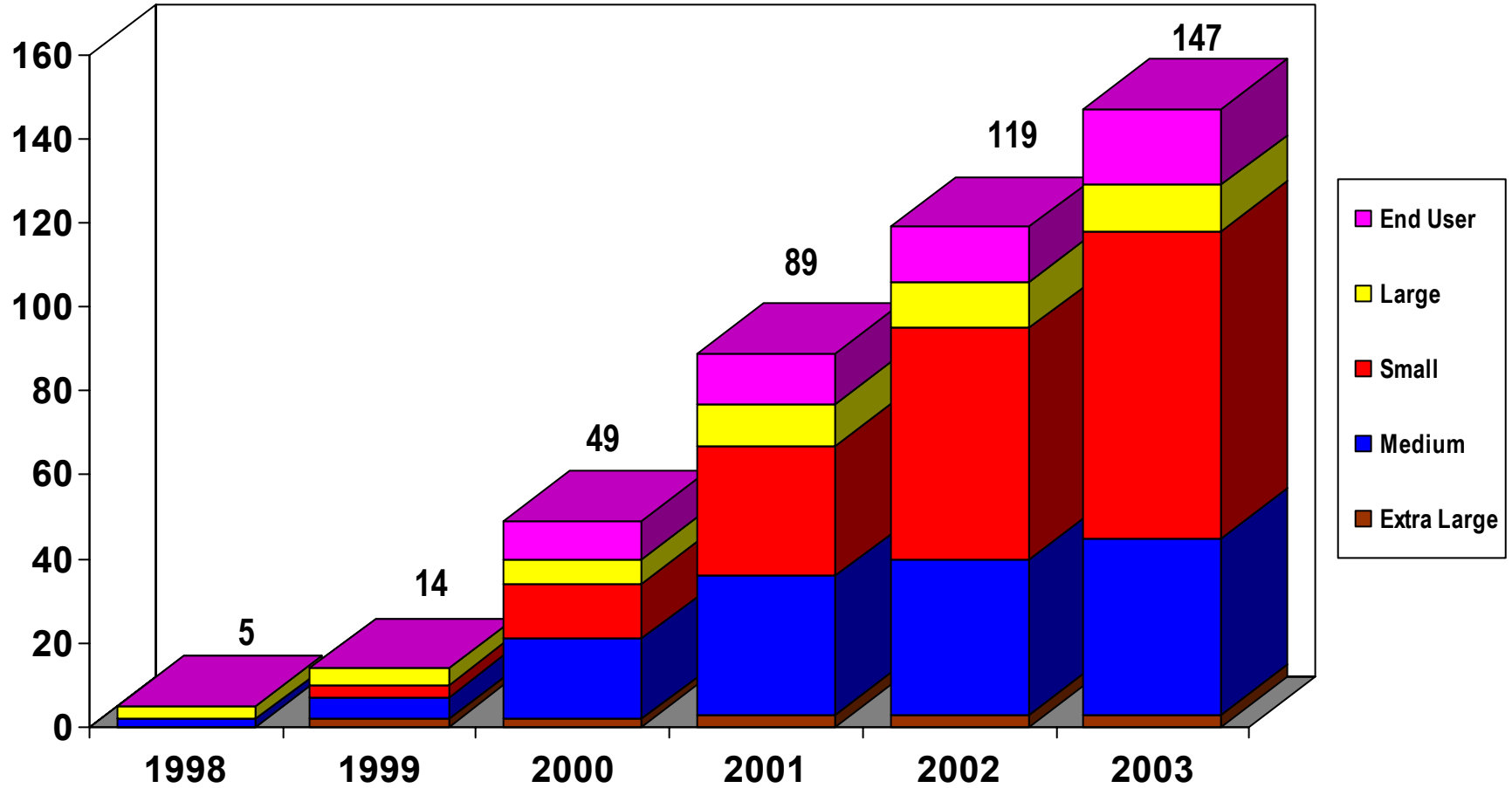
MEMBERSHIP DISTRIBUTION BY COUNTRY

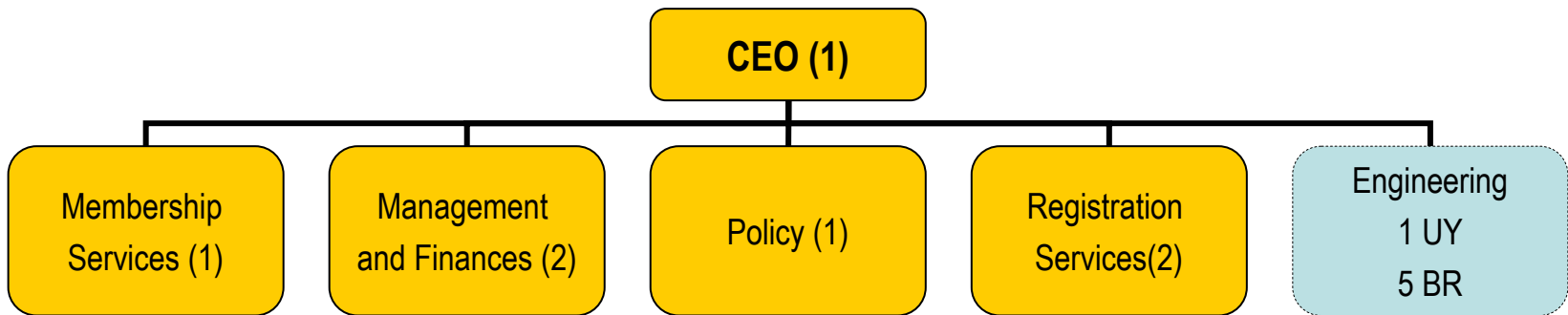
