- **IPv4 Unicast Address Block Allocations**
 - Submitted 17 January 2005 by APNIC, completed 27 January
 - Submitted 16 March by ARIN, completed 30 March (special)
- **IPv6 Unicast Address Block Allocations**
 - Submitted 30 November 2004 by RIPE NCC, completed 12 January
 - Submitted 15 December 2004 by ARIN, completed 19 April 2005
 - Submitted 16 March 2005 by RIPE NCC, completed 19 April 2005
- **Autonomous System (AS) Number Assignments**
 - Submitted 7 February 2005 by RIPE NCC, completed 8 February
 - Submitted 8 February 2005 by ARIN, completed 10 February
- IPv6 assignments will now be much more efficient

- 26 - 30 June 2006 – Marrakesh, Morocco

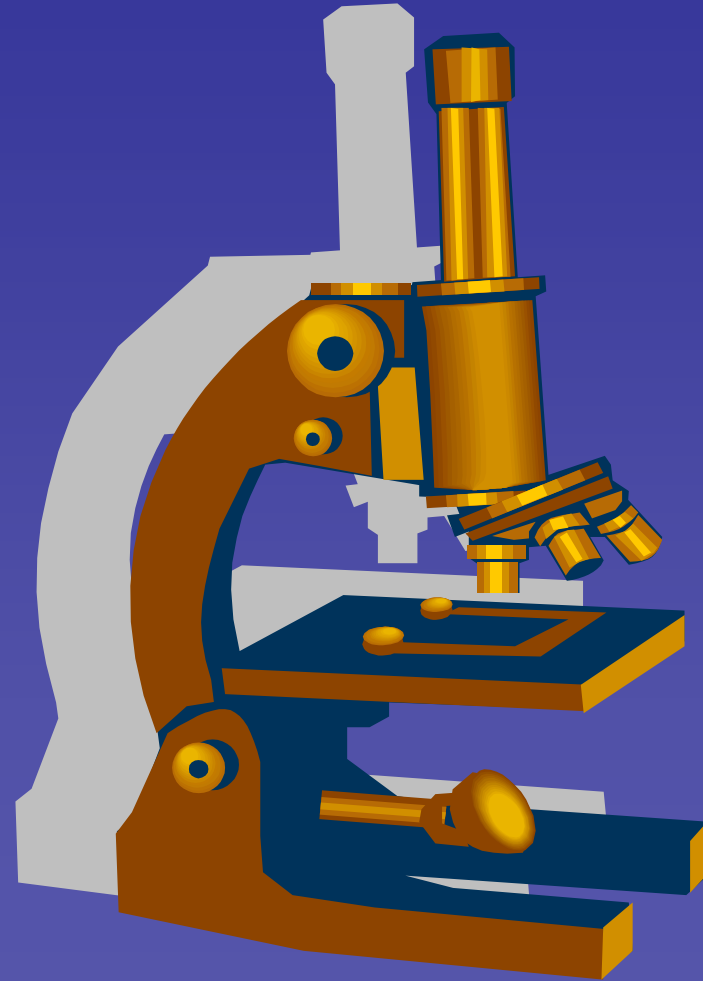
