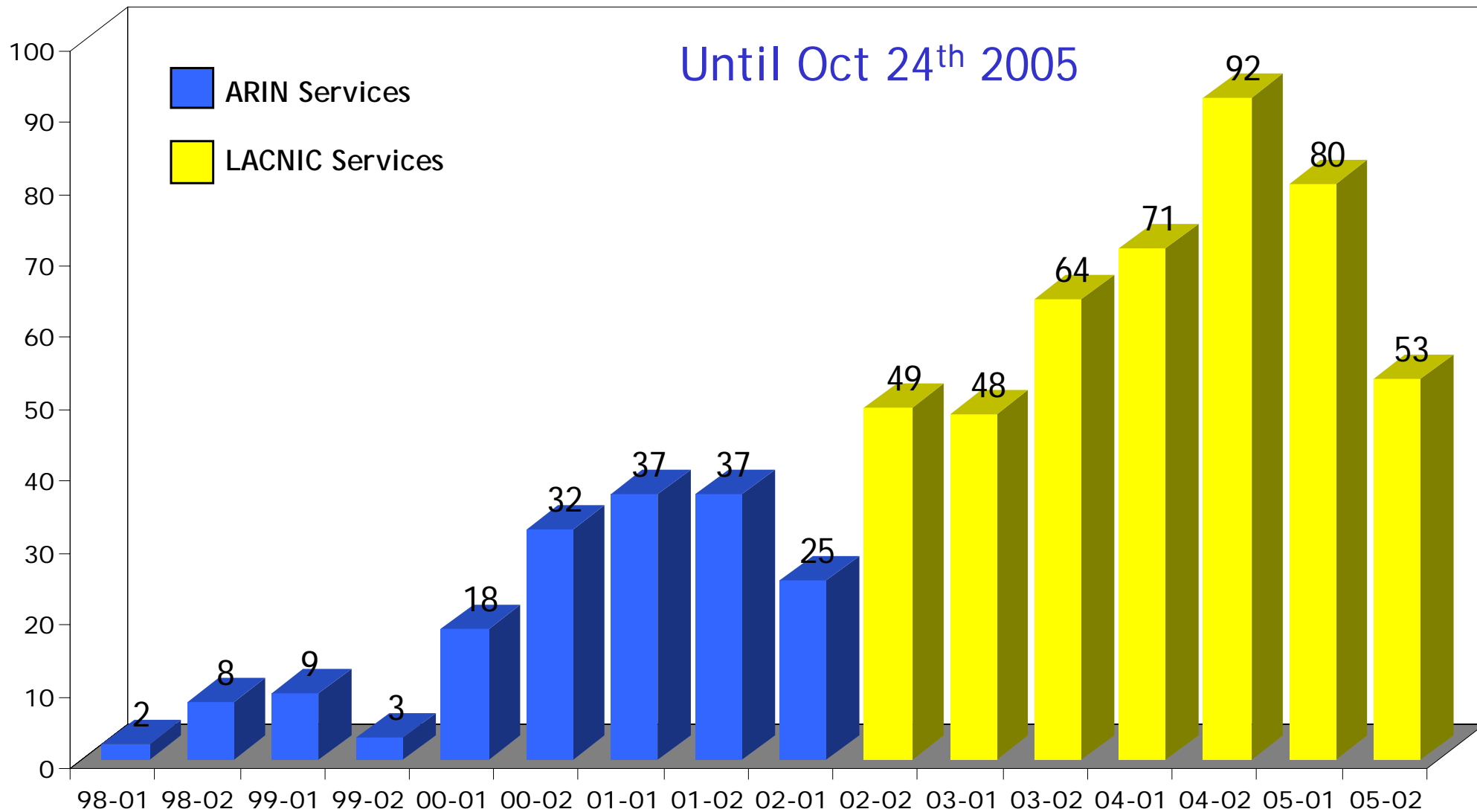




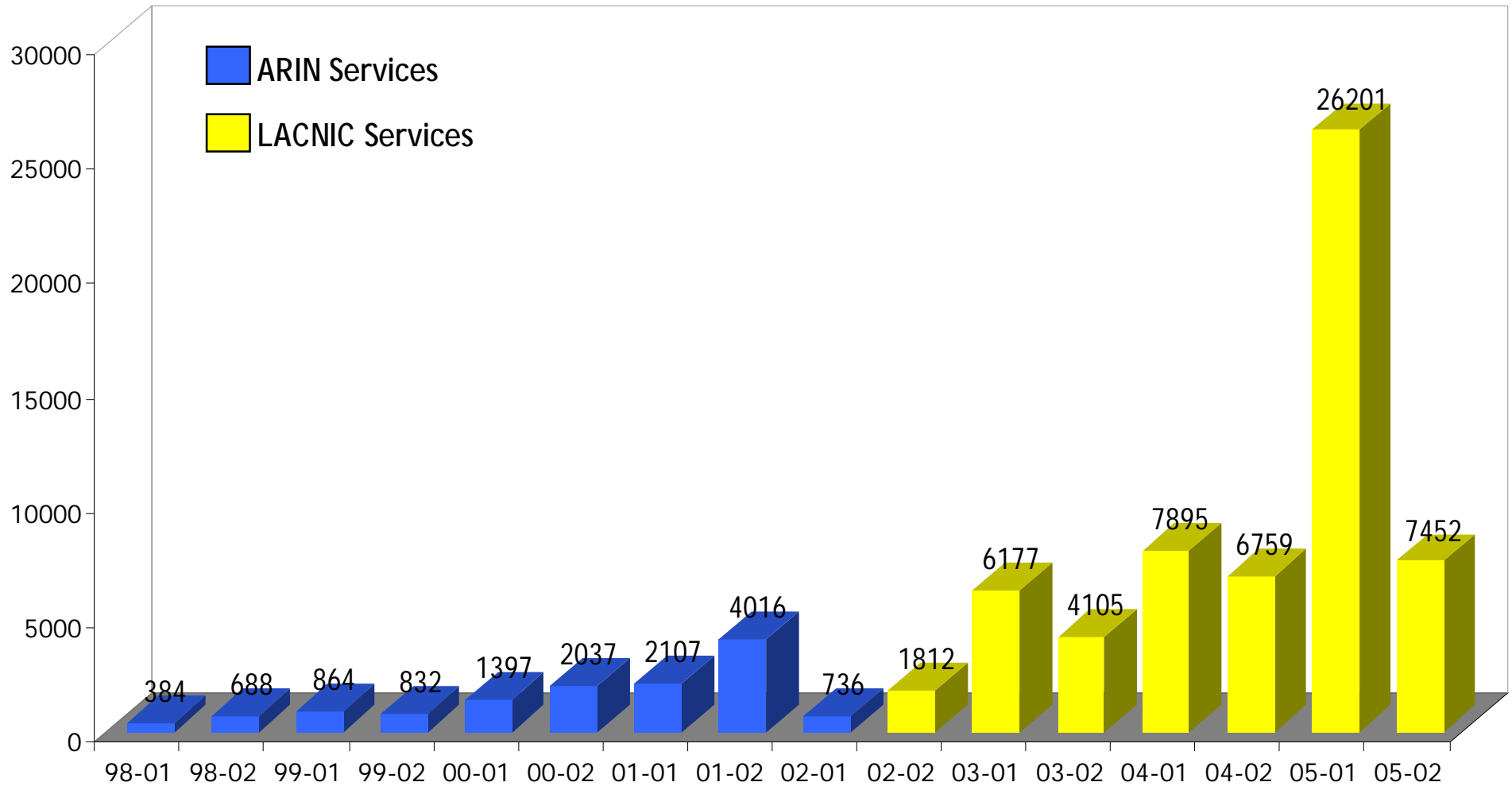

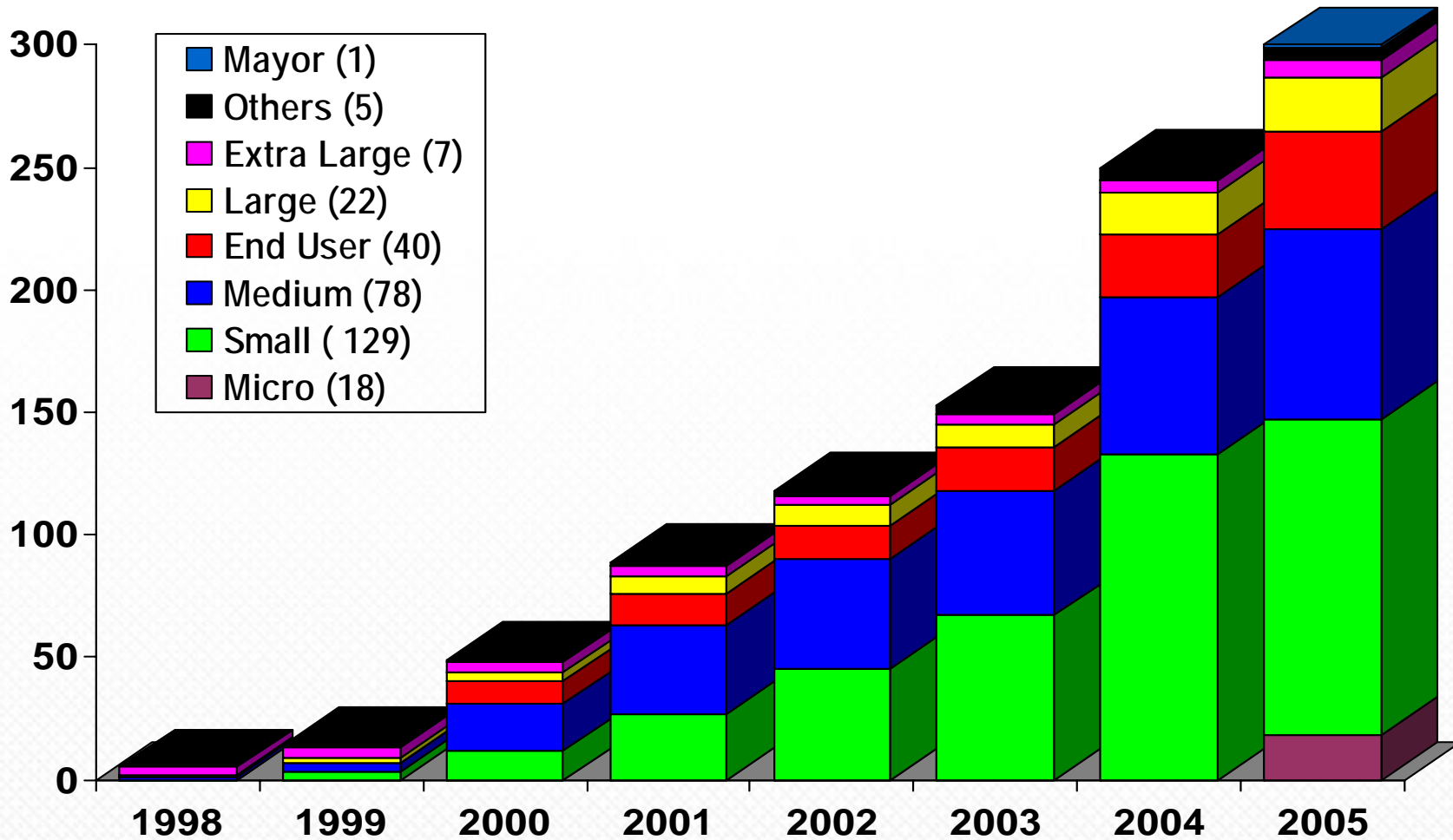

- 10 “one day” meetings for IPv6 promotion and outreach in different cities of the region.

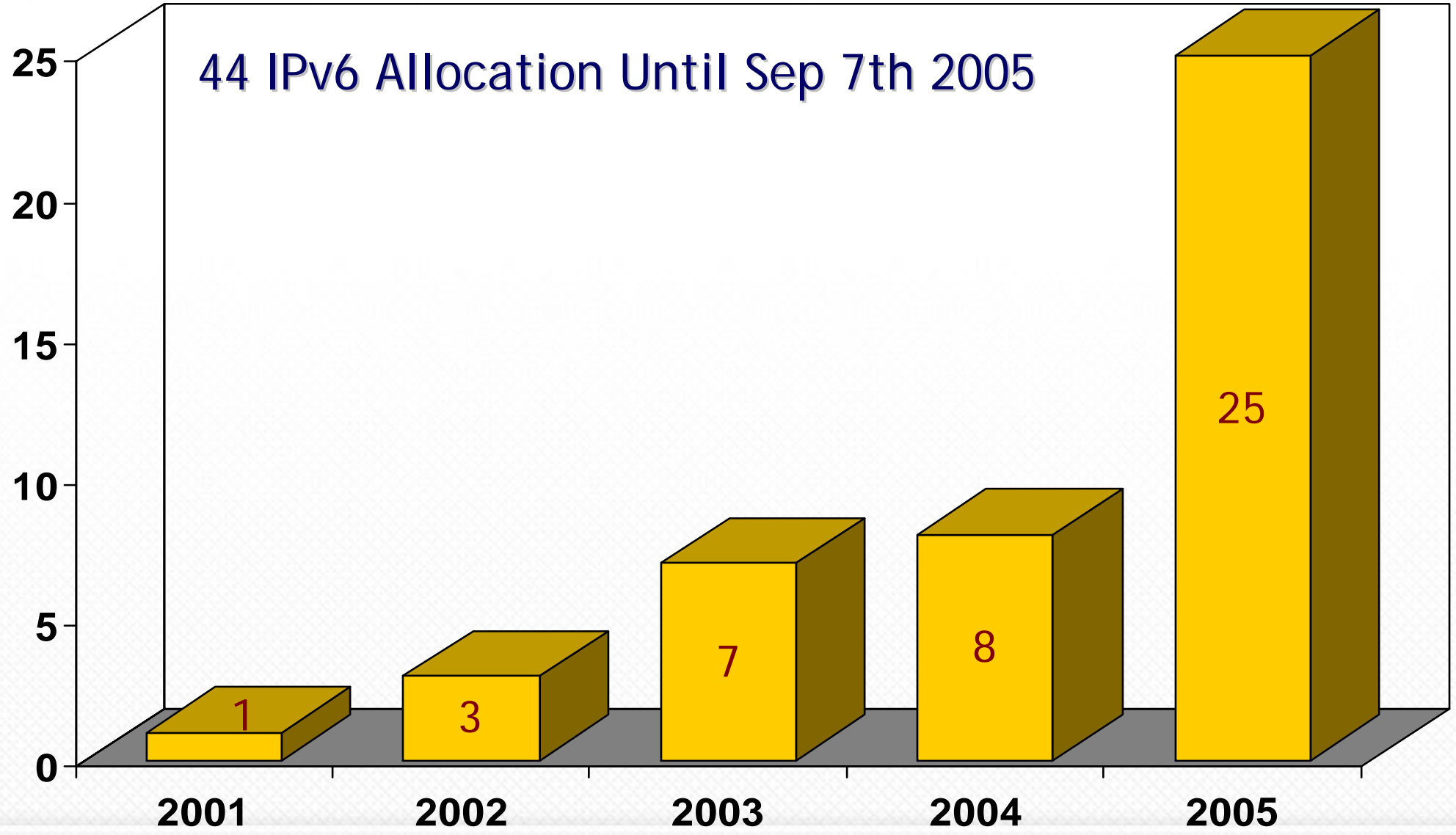

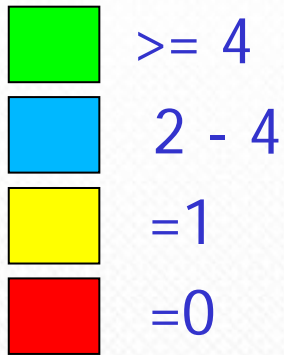
