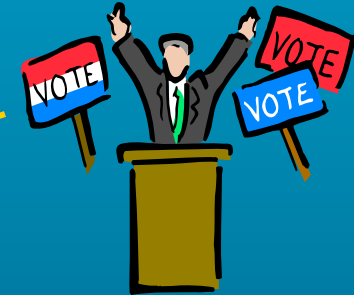

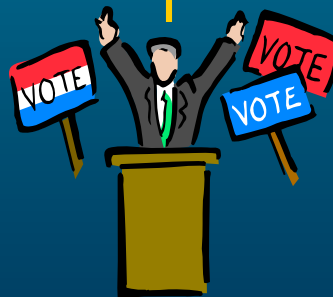

Candidates for the Board of Trustees and Advisory Council are invited to speak at the ARIN Members Meeting on Friday, 19 October.

**Frequently Asked Questions**

**Am I Eligible to Vote in the NRO Number Council Election?**  
Yes, if you are attending NANOG 41, ARIN XX, or are the designated member representative (DMR) for an ARIN General Member in good standing.

**Am I Eligible to Vote in the Board and Advisory Council Election?**  
Yes, if you are a designated member representative (DMR) from an ARIN General Member in good standing.

- Step 6: Select and answer two challenge questions
- Step 7: Select an election and proceed to the ballot

- Step 9: Confirm vote (Only confirmed votes will be counted)
