- + FRIDA -
 - Meeting in Montevideo with more than 70 participants from 10 countries.
 - Objective Promote the research in ICT related issues, help the researchers to get funding for their projects and promote FRIDA.
- Journalists' constest on Internet Governance.
 - 40 participants. Works submitted. Results will be announced very soon.
 - First year. Interesting experience.



Public Affairs

- Working in the creation of a Governmnet working group in LACNIC.
 - Similar endeavor than in ARIN region.
 - First meeting in Panama.
- Very active rol in governmental environments.
 - Submitting documents, providing information, proposing measures, giving presentations or just participating.
- Co-organizers of the second regional prepartory meeting of IGF.
 - 11-13 August Río de Janeiro
- Continue participation in IGF and its MAG.

Engineering projects - EPP

- Requests from members to have an alternative interface to register sub allocations/assignments and inverse delegation. Currently.
- Extensions done to the IETF Standards for EPP (Extensible Provision Protocol) to supports IP addresses and ASN
- LACNIC to provide the EPP interface in its systems and development libraries.
 - Members will be able to adjust their own internal IP management
 system to send information to LACNIC systems using this interface
 - Same "schema" to be extended to NIRs.
- Initial stage, EPP interface and libraries to LACNIC members.
 - Plan to have it for next meeting (May/2009)
- Second stage, EPP to NIRs.
 - Plan to have libraries by the end of 2009 and accepting information from NIRs only using this protocol by second half of 2010.

Engineering projects - RPKI

- LACNIC have being following discussions about this important subject very closely.
- It is now time to move forward and we are working now to deploy a Beta version of a RPKI system for our members.
- One person working full time on this.
- Beta system to
 - issue PKI Certificates with RFC 3779 extension and following profile as drafted in SIDR IETF WG
 - publish PKI material to public repositories
 - allow members to administer their PKI Certs and sign ROAs via web interface
- To form a task force among members in order to interact and help with improvements
- Plan to have it working by end of 2009

 - IPv6 training
 - RIRs' system tutorials
 - Support to meettings organized by other parties.
 - Bolivia, Paraguay, Honduras, Nicaragua, Panamá, Colombia, Sint Maarten, Trinidad y Tobago, Brazil among other venues.
