# WHOIS Clean Up Project

## Phase 1

- **Direct allocations & assignments**
  - IPv4, IPv6, ASNs, (includes legacy)
  - 32,947 e-mails in total (encompasses 42,920 distinct POCs)
  - 2,000 per week (665 on M, W, Fri)
  - Estimate ~4 months to complete

## Phase 2

- **Reassignments**
  - Expected start: end of summer
  - 31,378 reallocations
  - 327,630 detailed reassignments

# WHOIS Clean Up Stats

Apr 17 thru Apr 27

- 2,995 messages sent
- 162 New POC templates received
- ~250 bounced messages

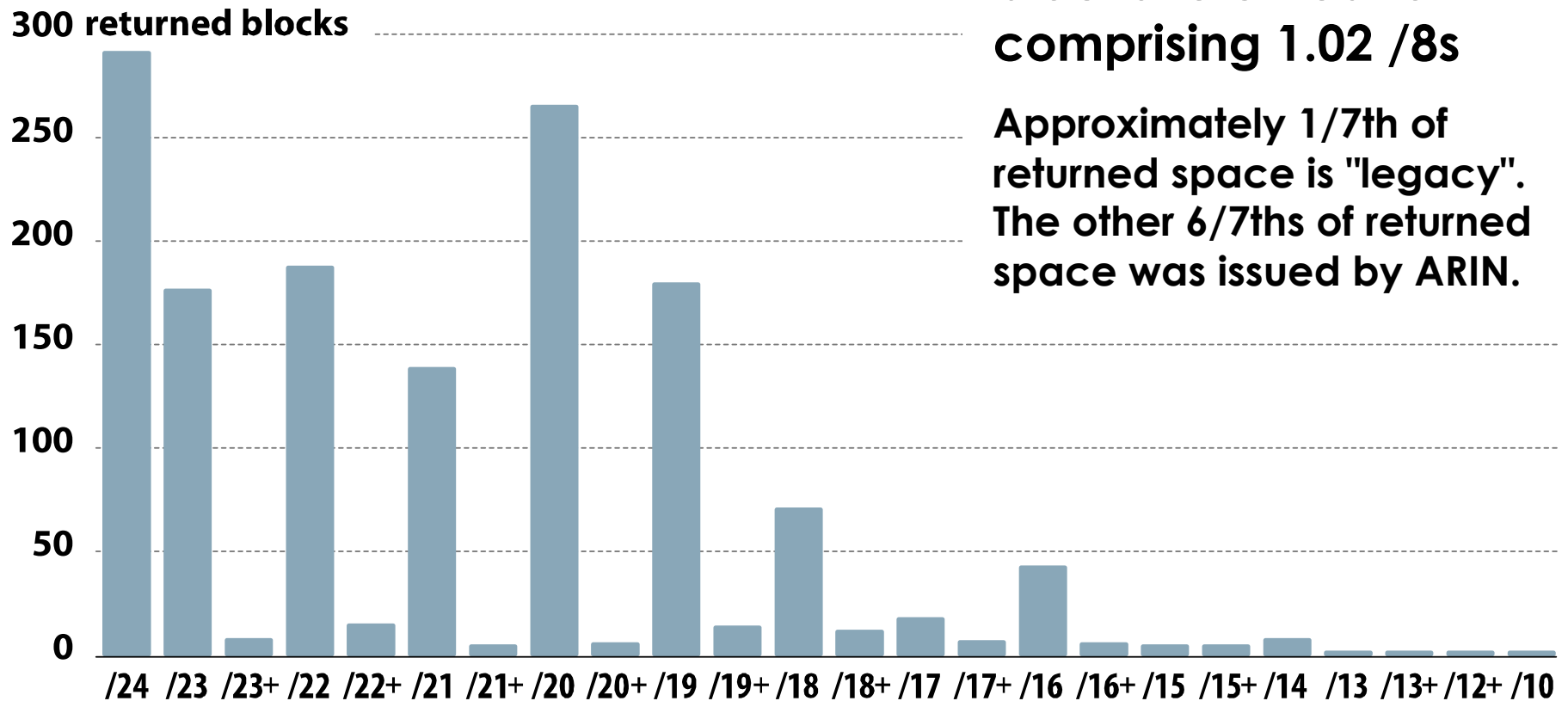

1,449 IPv4 address blocks returned to ARIN comprising 1.02 /8s

Approximately 1/7th of returned space is "legacy". The other 6/7ths of returned space was issued by ARIN.

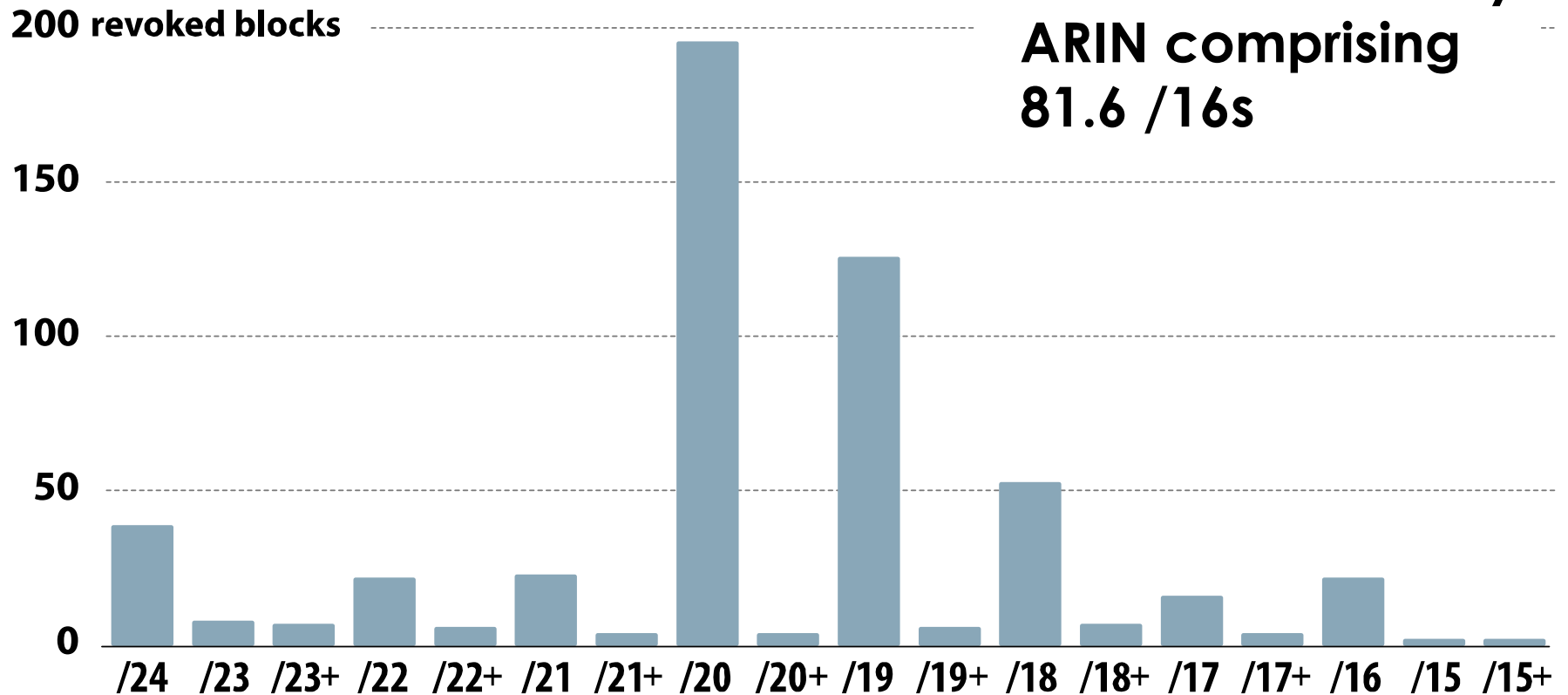




# Revoked Address Space
