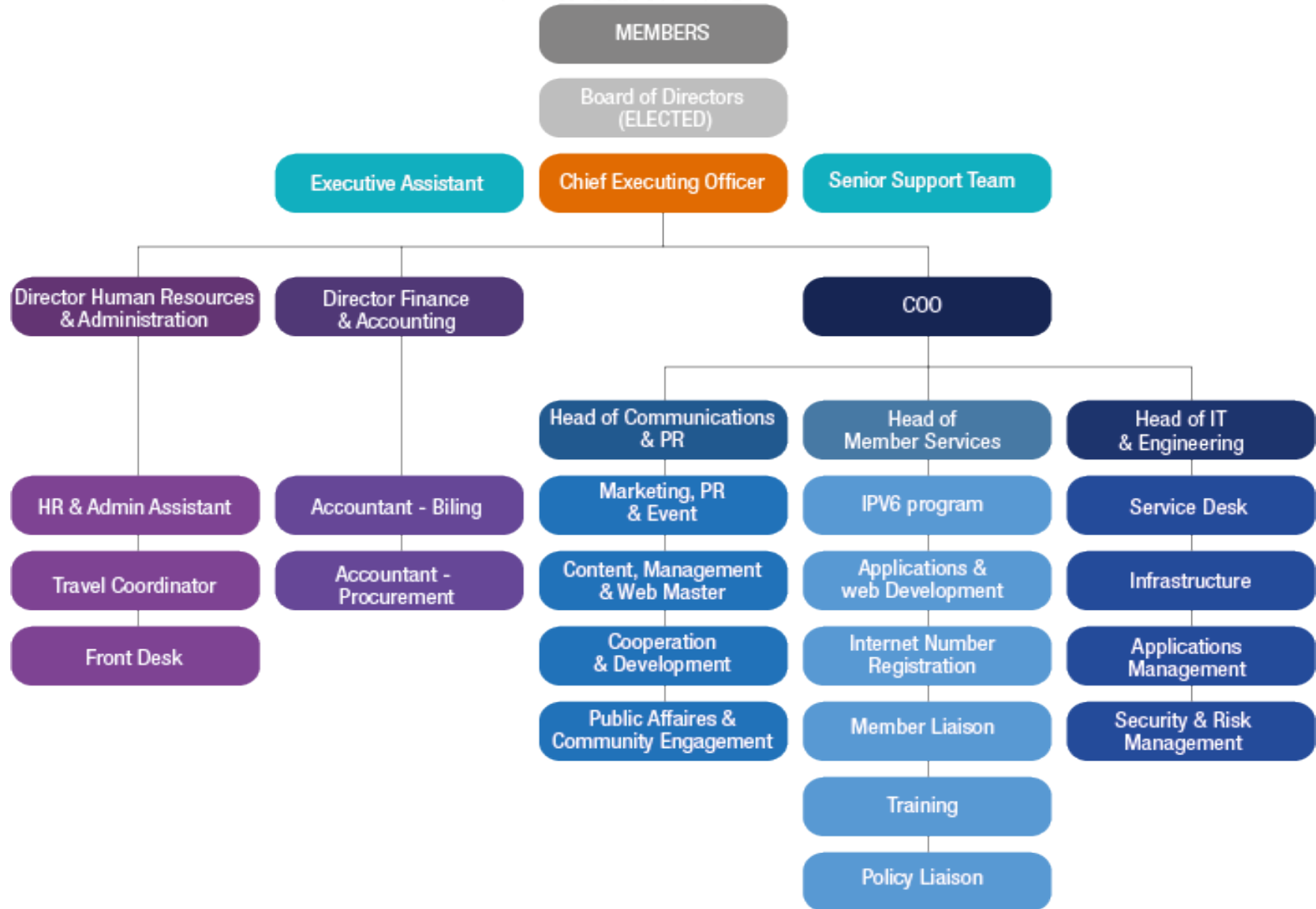

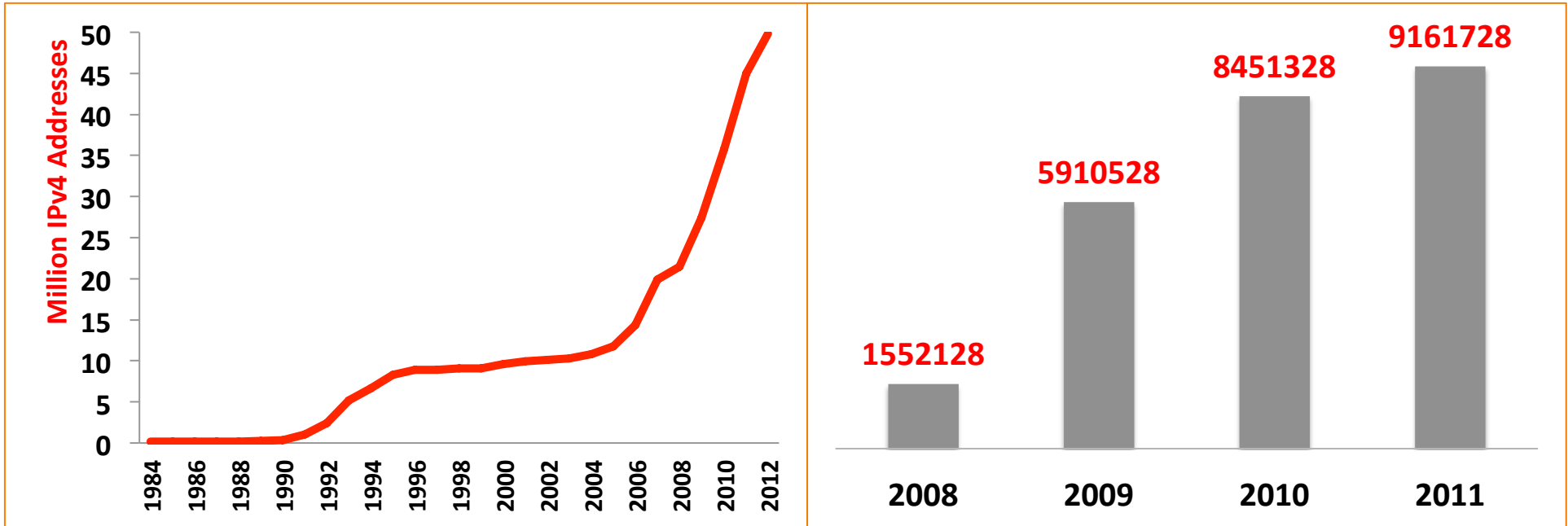


AFRINIC at Glance

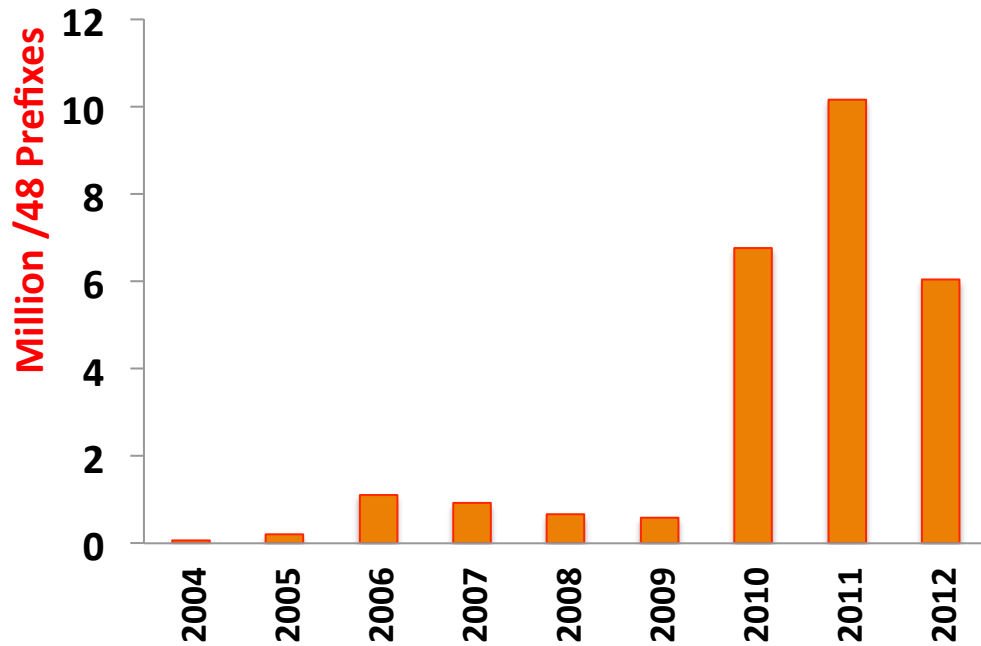

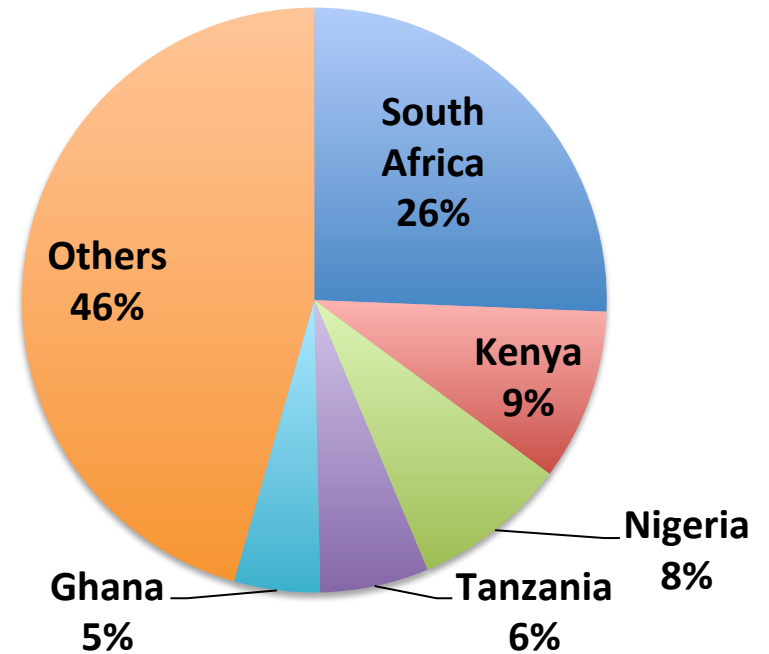
Total Allocation Trend:
