Statement of Support for the Formation of a Regional Internet Registry for Africa

ARIN supports the formation of a Regional Internet Registry for Africa. It is our firm belief that once ISP support has been completely established, a well-built and capable registry will emerge in Africa. We base this belief on the fact that there is support from the three existing RIRs, the 26 August 1999 statement of encouragement from the ICANN Board for the development of an RIR in Africa, and that a Board of Trustees is actively working to implement a corporate plan.

ARIN recognizes the efforts that are contributing to the formation of the Regional Internet Registry for Africa, such as formation of addressing policy, participation in the Address Council of the Address Supporting Organization, and the development of business operations. These efforts have built a strong foundation for your emerging registry.
