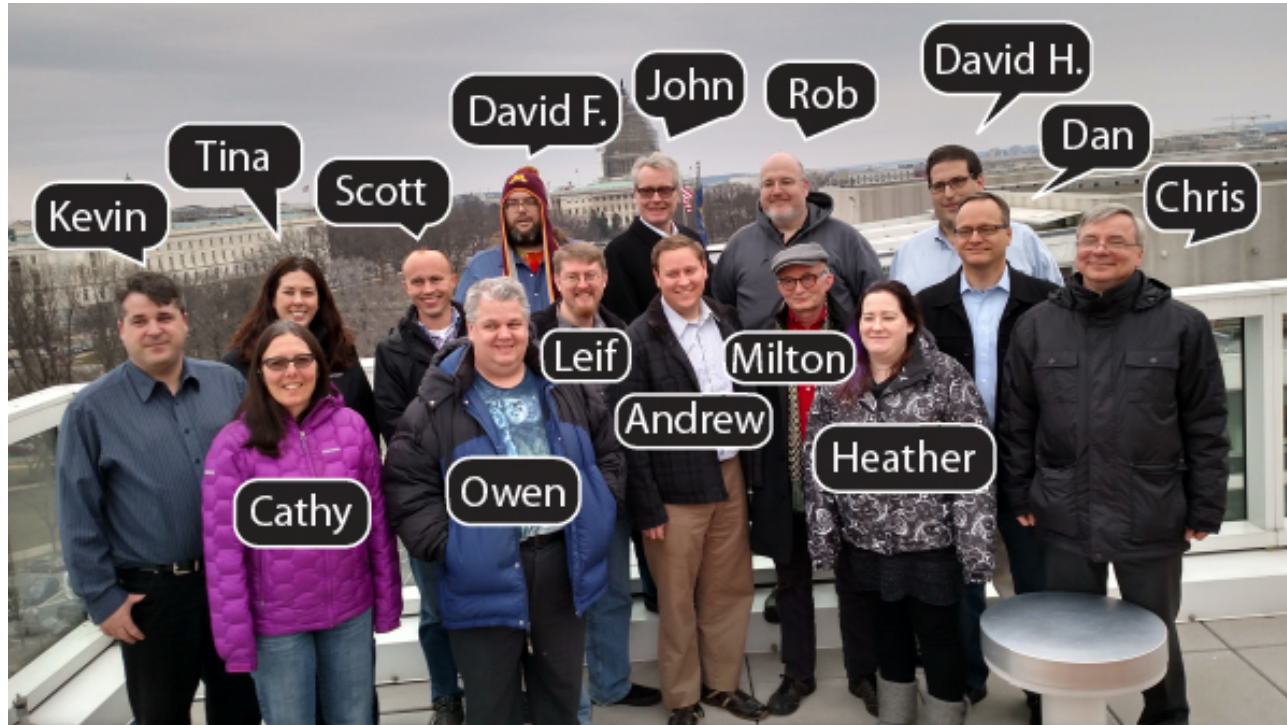

Advisory Council

“The Policy Development Process charges the member-elected ARIN Advisory Council (AC) as the primary facilitators of the process”

AC Role in the PDP

1. Work with author on proposals
Ensure clarity and valid problem statement
2. Work on Draft Policies
Gather input from the community and present to community for discussion
3. Work on Recommended Draft Policies
Find to be fair and impartial, technically sound, and supported by community; recommend adoption, present to community
4. Review Last Call
5. Recommend to the Board of Trustees

Policy Work

- 22 New Proposals in 2014
 - 7 Adopted (3 pending adoption)
 - 12 Abandoned
- 7 New Proposals so far in 2015
- 6 proposals discussed at ARIN 35
 - **2 moved to last call (sent to Board)**
 - **3 have been abandoned**
 - **1 work in progress**

- AC's docket today
 - 4 Draft Policies
 - In order to advance, the proposal must be fair/ impartial, technically sound, and supported by the community
 - Today's discussion will help the AC determine what happens with these drafts, ultimately they will either advance or be abandoned
 - Not eligible for last call (possibly eligible after ARIN 36 in Montreal)
 - 3 Proposals
 - Brand new

- 3 Proposals (continued)
 - Initial review – not yet draft proposals
 - Topics include
 - Clarifying requirements for using IP resources outside of the ARIN region
 - Consider utilization of resources used outside of the ARIN region
 - Simplifying needs requirements for IPv4 transfers
 - These three proposals will be reviewed during the AC's June meeting

- Staff Policy and Experience Report
 - Provides feedback to the community on where new or modified policy work may be needed
 - POC validation
 - 8.2 transfers due to reorganizations
 - Experience with /24's
 - Immediate need

Other AC Work

- Improve PPC Format
 - Provide background for newcomers
 - Add status updates
 - Open discussion looking for input
- Community Feedback
 - Polling a larger audience than a show of hands in the room
- NRPM Simplification
 - How do requirements change after the depletion of the free pool
 - Apply lessons learned from transfer policies
